The City Council of the City of Coleman, Texas will meet in session on Thursday, April 2, 2026, at 5:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 200 West Liveoak, Coleman, Texas. All items on the agenda are for possible discussion and action. Council may vote and/or act upon each of the items listed on this Agenda. One agenda item will be discussed at a time, in the order determined by the Mayor, unless logic and practical considerations allow similar topics to be considered together for purposes of convenience and efficiency. Consent items are considered to be non-controversial and will be voted on in one motion unless a council member asks for separate discussion. The City Council of the City of Coleman, Texas, reserves the right to meet in closed, executive session on any of the items listed below should the need arise and if authorized by Title 5, Chapter 551, of the Texas Government Code. 1. Call to Order, Invocation, and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flags of the United States of America and the State of Texas.
2. Introductions, Announcements, and Recognitions.
3. Items to be withdrawn.
4. Citizen Presentations: Any citizen who desires to address the City Council on a matter not included on the agenda may do so at this time. The City Council may not deliberate on items presented under this agenda item. Presentations are subject to five (5) minutes for items not on the agenda. If you wish to speak to an item on the agenda, you will be allowed to speak when the council addresses the item. There is a (3) minute time limit for items on the agenda. The presiding officer (with the consent of a majority of the City Council) may grant additional time. To comply with the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, the Council respectfully requests that prior to addressing Council, that each person submit a Speaker Request Form stating your name, address, and topic of presentation. The form is located at the entryway to Council Chambers.
5. Consider and act upon the approval of minutes for the City of Coleman Council Meeting held on March 26, 2026.


6. Hear presentation on the City of Coleman and City of Coleman Component Units Financial Statements and Independent Auditors Report for the period ending September 30, 2025.
7. Discuss, consider, and act upon adopting a Resolution of the City of Coleman adopting a 14-day work period for sworn law enforcement personnel pursuant to the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) 7(k) and to establish overtime compensation for hours worked with the 14-day work period FLSA 14-day 207(k) work period schedule for the Coleman Police Department.
8. The City Council may enter Executive Session to discuss the following pursuant to:
  - a) Government Code §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney) – Receive an update from the City Attorney regarding TDA Contract CDV23-0082.
  - b) Government Code §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney) – Discussion with City Attorney regarding management agreement with Chamber of Commerce.
  - c) Government Code §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney) Discuss Lease of City Property to Cornerstone Community Action Agency for the Coleman 150 Celebration.
  - d) Government Code §551.071 (Consultation with Attorney) and Government Code §551.076 (Security Devices) -Discussions with City Attorney associated with the Coleman 150 Celebration, including but not limited to public safety, planning, crowd management, contractual obligations, and potential financial commitments related to the event logistics.
  - e) Government Code §551.074 (Personnel Matters) the City Council may conduct the annual performance review and evaluation of the City Manager.
9. Upon returning to open session, the City Council may take whatever actions as they may deem appropriate regarding items discussed in Executive Session, including:
  - a) Discuss, consider, and act upon any action necessary regarding TDA Contract CDV23-0082.
  - b) Discuss, consider, and act upon approving an amendment to the Management Agreement with the Coleman County Chamber of Commerce.
  - c) Discuss, consider, and act upon authorizing the lease of the District 1876 Park to Cornerstone Community Action Agency for the Coleman 150 Celebration.
  - d) Discuss, consider, and act upon authorizing the City Manager to approve and expend funds related to the Coleman 150 Celebration.
  - e) Discuss, consider, and act upon the annual performance review and evaluation of the City Manager.
