Also a part of the Coleman ISD Foundation's goals are to provide grants to faculty of Coleman ISD to assist them with supplies, activities, staff development, curriculum, or other needs they may have. Grant applications have been sent out to the faculty and the Coleman ISD Foundation board will select one or more applications to be awarded a grant.

One of the fundraisers the Foundation holds each year is providing school supplies for parents of elementary and junior high students.
