The City Council of the City of Coleman, Texas will meet in session on Thursday, May 21, 2026, at 5:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 200 West Liveoak, Coleman, Texas. All items on the agenda are for possible discussion and action. Council may vote and/or act upon each of the items listed on this Agenda. One agenda item will be discussed at a time, in the order determined by the Mayor, unless logic and practical considerations allow similar topics to be considered together for purposes of convenience and efficiency. Consent items are considered to be non-controversial and will be voted on in one motion unless a council member asks for separate discussion. The City Council of the City of Coleman, Texas, reserves the right to meet in closed, executive session on any of the items listed below should the need arise and if authorized by Title 5, Chapter 551, of the Texas Government Code. 2. Introductions, Announcements, and Recognitions.
3. Items to be withdrawn.
4. Citizen Presentations: Any citizen who desires to address the City Council on a matter not included on the agenda may do so at this time. The City Council may not deliberate on items presented under this agenda item. Presentations are subject to five (5) minutes for items not on the agenda. If you wish to speak to an item on the agenda, you will be allowed to speak when the council addresses the item. There is a (3) minute time limit for items on the agenda. The presiding officer (with the consent of a majority of the City Council) may grant additional time. To comply with the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, the Council respectfully requests that prior to addressing Council, that each person submit a Speaker Request Form stating your name, address, and topic of presentation. The form is located at the entryway to Council Chambers.
5. Consider and act upon the approval of minutes for the City of Coleman Council Meeting held on May 7, 2026.

6. Discuss, consider, and act upon a request for Hotel Occupancy Tax Funds from the Coleman PRCA Rodeo Association in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the 2026 Coleman PRCA Rodeo, to be held on June 10-13, 2026, at the Coleman Rodeo Grounds.
7. Discuss, consider, and act upon approving a Resolution of the City of Coleman authorizing the City to enter into an agreement with Texas Department of Transportation for the temporary closure of portions of State Highway 153 and State Highway 206 for the 2026 Rodeo Parade to be held on June 13, 2026.
8. Discuss, consider, and act upon the acceptance of the resignation of Tammy Swening from the City of Coleman Public Library Advisory Board and the appointment of Delesa Wise to fill the remainder of the term.
9. Discuss, consider, and act upon a request from Lexi Olinger Haynes for use of the Coleman City Park facilities on Saturday, June 6, 2026, for a public Open Mic Night event with food vendors, and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Facility Use Agreement.
10. Discuss, consider, and act upon a request from Shelby Moore for use of the Coleman City Park facilities from June 18 through June 21, 2026, for a public church-sponsored event, and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Facility Use Agreement.
11. Discuss, consider, and act upon a request from Coleman Today and Double Dog Coffee for use of District 1876 Park on July 4, 2026, for a public community event celebrating America's 250th Anniversary, and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Facility Use Agreement.

Receive an update, discuss, and provide direction regarding the framework for a proposed ordinance establishing comprehensive regulations governing the use, operation, and management of City parks and recreational areas, including District 1876 Park, Mills Park, Coleman City Park, Press Morris Park, Lake Coleman, and Memory Lake.
