To the Citizens of Santa Anna,

What Residents Should Know

The primary concern with this storm is ice accumulation on roads, trees, and power lines, which may lead to hazardous travel conditions and possible service interruptions.

- Please limit travel when possible to reduce risk
- If travel is necessary, slow speeds are critical
- Avoid and report any downed utility lines — do not approach them
- Check on elderly neighbors, family, and friends


Important Reminder

- For fire, medical, or police emergencies, always call 911 or if not an emergency 325-625-3506 option 1 Dispatch.
- For utility outages or water issues, call (325) 348-3403.

After hours/weekends: same call 325-348-3403 if that doesn't work then 325-625-3506 option 1 Dispatch.

How You Can Prepare at Home

- Protect exposed pipes and drip faucets as needed
- Charge cell phones and backup batteries
- Prepare for possible power or water interruptions
- Continue to monitor local weather updates

 Response times may be slower during severe weather, as icy conditions can temporarily limit safe access. Crews will respond as soon as it is safe to do so.

If we lose power the Santa Anna Armory 303 South Houston St, Santa Anna, Texas, will be used as a warming area.
