6. Read with John Wayne and he will show you the Great Western Trail Map
7. Where Circle C Cattlewomen show their mark
8. GWT Marker- Most obvious at the "County Seat"
9. Character from the pioneer days
10. Chuckwagon
11. Where the trail meets the sentence
12. Keeps you warm where our heritage is exhibited
13. GWT Marker- BONUS- Wandering stray marker within Coleman city limits (finding this gets you extra points)
14. GWT Marker- Few miles north of town on HWY 283, where cows cross the creek
15. GWT Marker- Don't stray off the highway but continue north to Hemphill Ranch
16. GWT Marker- Just past the county line, north of Crooked Creek
