### **Survey Methodology**

These Keating – Onsight - Melanson (KOM Poll) Colorado Statewide Voter Poll results are based on a sample of 600 online surveys among likely November 2020 voters statewide in Colorado. The poll was conducted from May 1-3, 2020. The worst case margin of error at the 95% level for the split sample of 600 is plus or minus 4.0%. Keating Research, OnSight Public Affairs and Melanson paid for and conducted this poll.
