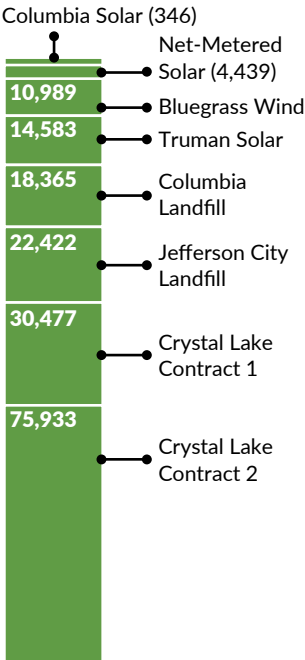


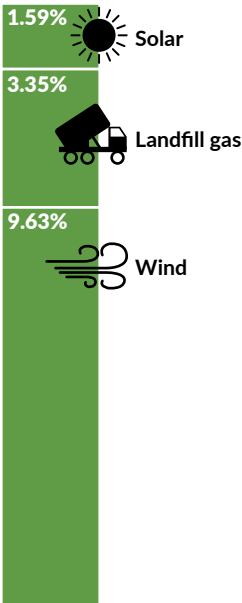
Most renewable energy in Columbia came from wind sources in 2021

Two-thirds of the city's 177,554 megawatt hours of renewable energy came from wind sources last year. At 14.57% of the total electric portfolio, the city fell short of its 15% goal for renewable energy.
