Your guide to getting to the Roots N Blues Festival


Roots N Blues Festival is happening Sept. 24-26 in Stephens Lake Park. Here's a guide on parking, street closures and shuttles for the festival.

Traffic restrictions

Beginning 3 p.m. Friday and 11 a.m. Saturday and Sunday, **Old 63** will be northbound only from **Jack Estes Way to Hinkson Avenue. E. Walnut Street** will be westbound only from **Old 63 to William Street**.

E. Walnut Street from Old 63 to the dead end will be closed to traffic.

Vehicles dropping off attendees should pull into the **spraygrounds lot** off Old 63.



Shuttles

With limited parking around the festival, attendees are encouraged to park downtown and use the free shuttle service.

Free shuttles will run starting at 3 p.m. Friday and 10:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday.

Shuttles will pick up after the final performance each night at the **Riechmann Pavilion parking lot**.

Parking

Parking in the E. Walnut neighborhood will be restricted to people with passes.

Downtown parking garages are free after 6 p.m. Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday.

ADA-accessible parking will be available at the **Riechmann Pavilion**.
