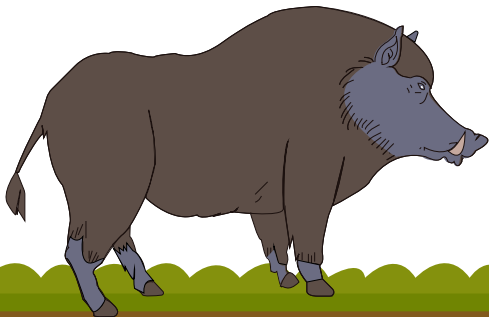


Feral hogs: Spreading disease and destruction across Missouri
