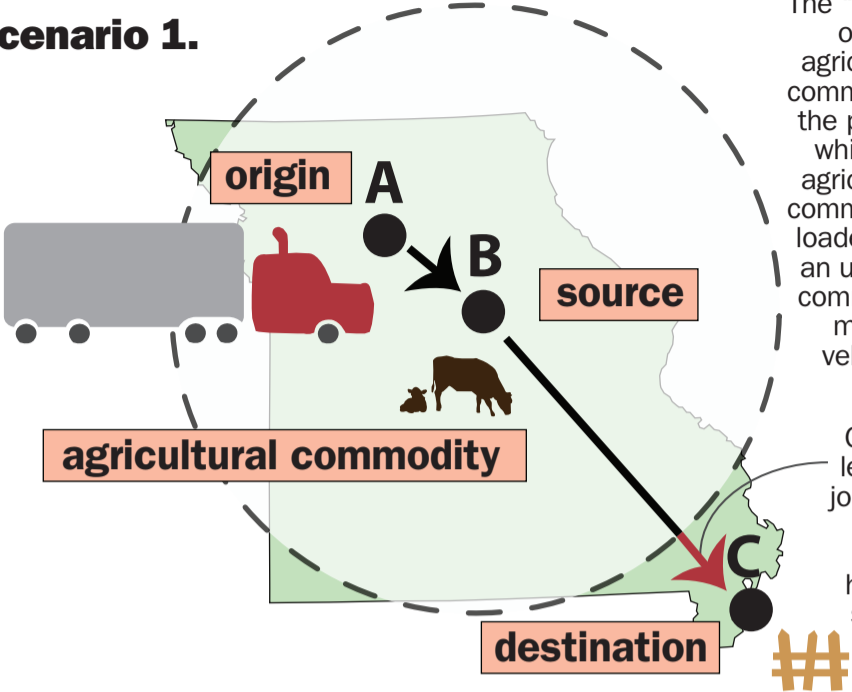


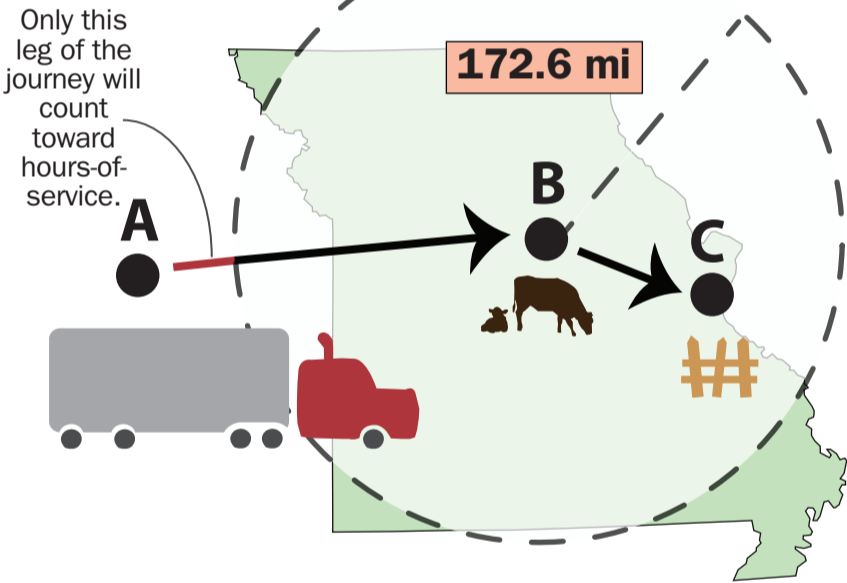
Exemption area covers most of Missouri

Under the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's new guidelines, agricultural haulers only need to track their hours when they're operating outside a 150-air-mile radius (about 172.6 miles) around the location where they load the commodity. While driving within the exemption zone, they're no longer required to log hours.
