
## City not yet disconnecting unpaid utilities accounts

For months, Columbia didn't disconnect utilities for people who couldn't pay because of COVID-19. But after the city said it would resume disconnections Sept. 25, more people have paid their bills. In less than two weeks, more than 2,300 delinquent accounts — worth about \$858,000 — were paid.
