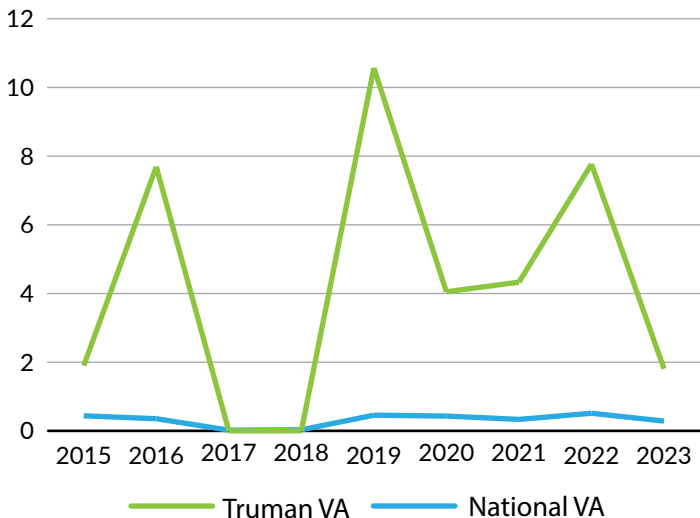


Truman versus national VA seclusion rates

Seclusion is a protocol used to confine a patient, and Truman Veterans' Hospital reported rates well above the national average for nine years. There are two years of outlier data — 2017 and 2018 — where only four VA medical centers reported a rate other than zero or “N/A.”
