

Columbia prioritizes roads during winter storms

The roads in Columbia are plowed according to a set schedule. **First priority roads** are major residential or through roads that are needed for public safety needs.

Second priority roads are heavily travelled roads, city and school bus routes and streets that connect to schools, hospitals and other critical areas of Columbia.

Third priority roads are ones that help gain access to first and second priority roads and are some residential neighborhoods.

Some of the major highways and streets are plowed by the **Missouri Department of Transportation** (MoDOT).

Priority roads are plowed and treated 24 hours a day, as needed during winter weather.
