


What inmates across Missouri are charged for the cost of their own jail time

Charging “board bills” to people stuck in county jails is a common practice. Some Missouri counties collect more than others, and in fiscal year 2017, Laclede County collected over \$260,000 in board bills, while Camden County took in over \$240,000. By contrast, Boone County collected \$272.
