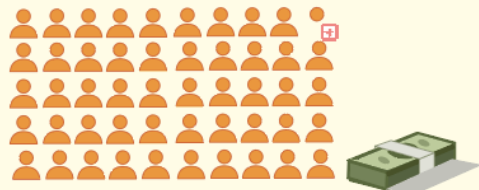
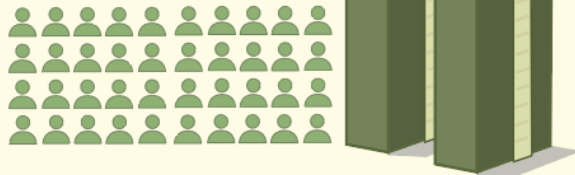


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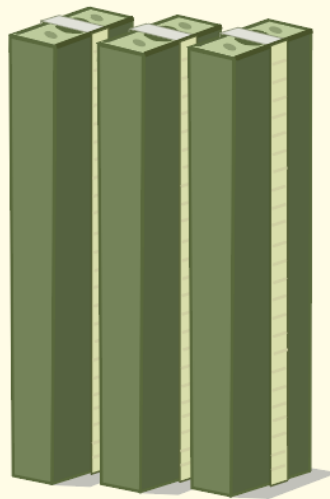
The bottom 50% owns 1% of the nation's wealth

In 2019, a family in the bottom 50% had less than \$122,000 in wealth. There are 64.3 million families in this category. Around 13.4 million families (or 1 in 10) in this group had negative net worth, meaning they owe more than they own.



The middle 40% owns 22% of the nation's wealth

A family needed at least \$122,000 or more to be in top 40%. There are 51.5 million families in this category.



The top 10% owns 76% of the nation's wealth

A family needed \$1.22 million or more in wealth to be in top 10%. There are 12.9 million families in this category.
