## Proposed city ordinance short-term rental tiers

The ordiance limits short-term rentals (STRs) two ways: a tier system and general provisions that apply to all STRs.



## Tier 1

STR can be rented a maximum of 30 days each year

## Tier 2

STR can be rented a maximum of 120 days each year Tier 3
