

Radon levels in Fredal and his neighbor's house were well over safe benchmarks

The American Lung Association (ALA) recommends radon reduction measures if testing shows interior radon levels at or above 2 pCi/L (picoCuries per liter of air), a common unit of measurement for the concentration of radioactivity in a gas. The EPA only recommends mitigation action beyond 4 pCi/L. Here's how these benchmarks compare to radon tests Fredal conducted.
