

City of Columbia recall process

The last time a councilperson was successfully recalled was in 1990. Elected officials cannot be recalled during the first or last 6 months of their term. If recalled, an official becomes ineligible to serve in any city office for the duration of the term for which they were elected. However: If an officer is retained by a recall election, they shall not be subject to recall within a period of 6 months thereafter.
