1. I have probable cause to believe that on 12/09/2018, at
3930 S PROVIDENCE RD - A, COLUMBIA, MO 65203,
TRE'ALLEN WILLIAMS B/M
committed one or more criminal offense(s):
565.073-003Y201713 DOMESTIC ASSAULT - 2ND DEGREE
F/M: F COUNTS: 1 CHARGE TYPE: S

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

On 12/9/2018 at approximately 0144 hours, I was dispatched to 3930-A S
Providence Road in Columbia, Missouri, for a report of a physical domestic.
While en route, the complainant advised she was in the parking lot of Castle
Car Wash.

I arrived at Castle Car Wash, 3919 Peachtree Drive, and made contact with the
victim, [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] stated she was in an argument with her boyfriend, Tre Williams, at
Fieldhouse Bar. [REDACTED] stated she left Fieldhouse and later picked up Williams
at Shakespeare's. [REDACTED] stated she and Williams got into a verbal argument and
she began to drive to William's friends house, where Williams requested to
go. [REDACTED] stated while she was driving on South Providence near the Mizzou
Athletics Training Center, Williams grabbed the steering wheel and tried to
wreck the car and make [REDACTED] pull over. [REDACTED] stated Williams did this two more
times, a second time near the Nifong and Providence intersection and again
near 3930 S Providence Road near The Lyfe Apartments.

[REDACTED] stated she made it near The Lyfe Apartments and Williams was still being
dramatic so she told him she would just take him home. [REDACTED] stated she made
it near the Naught-Naught building on South Providence and pulled over
because Williams kept hitting her with his forearm, elbow, and slapping her
on the chest. [REDACTED] stated she also pulled over because Williams was still
trying to pull her car over by grabbing the wheel. [REDACTED] stated she then told
Williams to get out, he wouldn't, so she threw his phone out of the car. [REDACTED]
stated Williams got out to get his phone, she opened her door and grabbed his
phone, and closed her door. [REDACTED] stated Williams reached through her open,
driver side window and began choking her with both hands.

[REDACTED] stated she rolled the window up on Williams and then put the car in
drive and drove off, which made Williams stop choking her. [REDACTED] stated when
Williams was choking her, Williams said, "Give me my phone before I fucking
hurt you."

█████ stated when Williams was choking her she could not breathe and thought Williams was going to make her pass out. █████ stated she believed her life was in danger, and she found Williams choking her as offensive. █████ stated she was lightheaded, had a sore throat, and her voice was more hoarse than normal.

I observed distinct red swelling on K.H.'s throat, consistent with being strangled.

I located and arrested Williams for Domestic Assault in the Second Degree (RSMO 565.073)
