

Five steps to prepare for the 2020 AP exams

Advanced Placement exams are set to take place online this year and began May 11. Students can now check the AP exam testing schedule and course-specific exam information on the College Board website at collegeboard.org.



Try the exam demo

Students can now take a video tour of online exams, review ways to submit exam responses and launch an interactive exam demo and practice submitting online.

Complete exam day checklist

Students can now review the exam checklist, download required exam documents and review course-specific information, like reference sheets.



Confirm your email address

The College Board will send an AP ID and an e-ticket to the email address associated with each account.

Locate your e-ticket

E-tickets will be emailed to students two days before each exam and will include the AP ID and a start time for the exam, which may vary depending on the time zone.



Check in 30 minutes early

Students can use their e-ticket to check in to the online exam 30 minutes before the start time. If students are having technical issues, they can request a makeup exam.
