
City projects green energy output will begin exceeding goals starting in 2024

In 2021, Columbia's renewable energy goal was for 15% of its total energy output to be renewable. It reached 14.63%, failing to meet the goal. However, the city expects to consistently surpass the renewable energy standard beginning in 2024.
