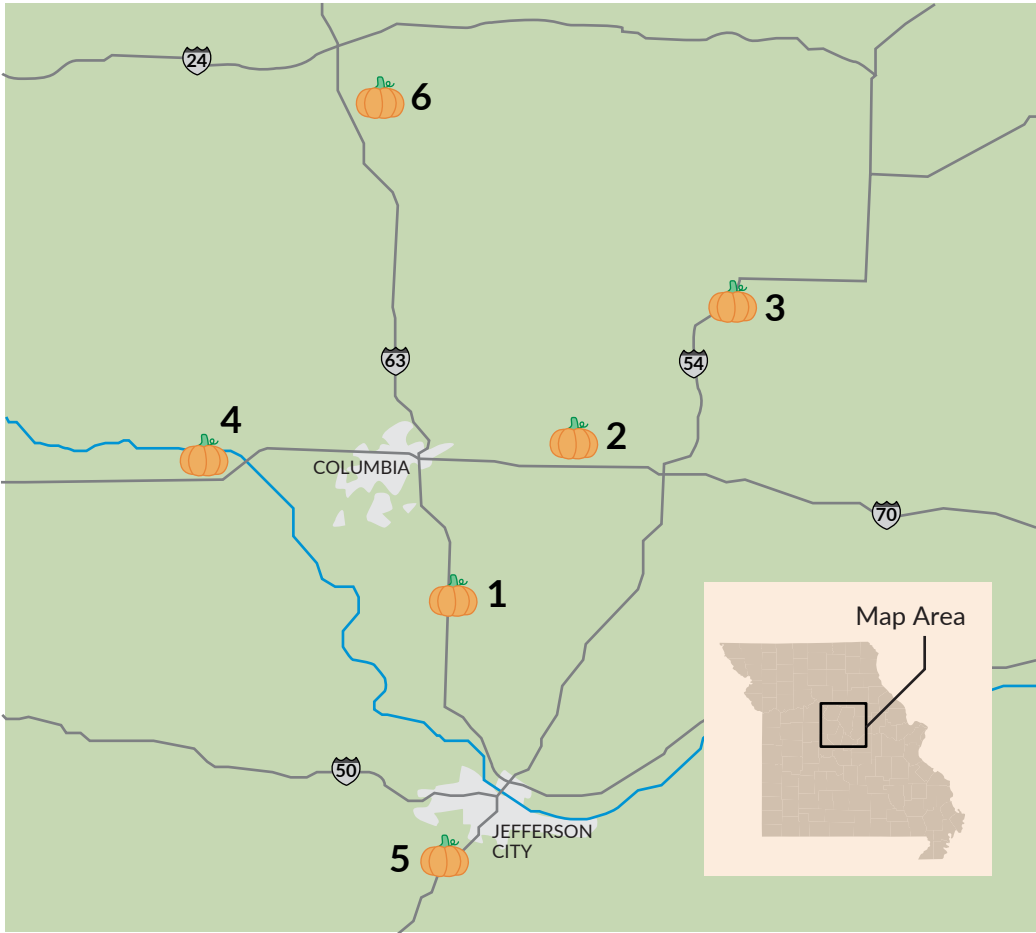


Local farms gear up for fall family fun
