

Eight-man vs. 11-man



Main differences



1. Player numbers

The main difference is the reduced players, eight instead of 11. Players need to play different positions, and all jersey numbers are eligible to catch a pass.

2. Field size

An eight-man field is smaller than a traditional 11-man one. It is 80 yards long and 40 yards wide, instead of 100 x 53 1/3.



3. High scores

Scoring is easier, and the typical game will be in the 40-60 point range, with low scores being in the 20s and shootouts in the 70s.
