Can I register to vote?

To register, voters must be 17.5 years old (18 years old to vote), a U.S. citizen and a resident of Missouri.





What is the Registration deadline?


This year, voter registration ends on Oct. 12. Voter registration by mail must be postmarked on or before this date.

How do I register to vote?

Where to go:

 **Online:** To register to vote or update your voter registration, visit the Boone County Clerk Office's website and complete the appropriate form.

 **By Mail:** To mail a Missouri Voter Registration Application, print the form listed on the County Clerk's website or pick up a postcard registration form at government buildings, libraries, post offices or select stores. Forms should be sent to the Boone County Clerk's Office at 801 E. Walnut St., Room 236.

 **In-person:** Registration is held at the County Clerk's office Monday through Friday, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Required Documents:

To register to vote in Missouri, you must provide a form of identification such as:

- a driver's license
- birth certificate

These forms of identification can be expired.

To cast your vote in November, a valid, unexpired form of identification will be required.
