Men vs. Women



Only 0.9% of diagnosed cases are men; however, the same Clinical Prognostic Stage tests are used for **all** patients.

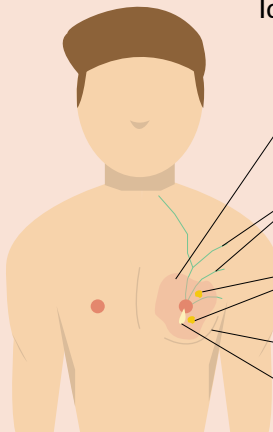


Regardless of gender, the human body can have increased risks due to a family history of breast cancer and increased estrogen.



Out of the 2,800 men who will be diagnosed this year, 83.8% will survive compared to 90.8% of the 297,790 women.

Identifiable Symptoms



Increased redness and swelling around the affected area.

Swelling and lumps can form within the lymph nodes running along the breast and armpit.

Tumors, as well as lumps that can form, are **most commonly** found slightly above or below the nipple.

Changes in the size and shape of the breast are a common indicator of the lumps that can be felt.

Discharge of fluids from the nipple, especially if bloody.
