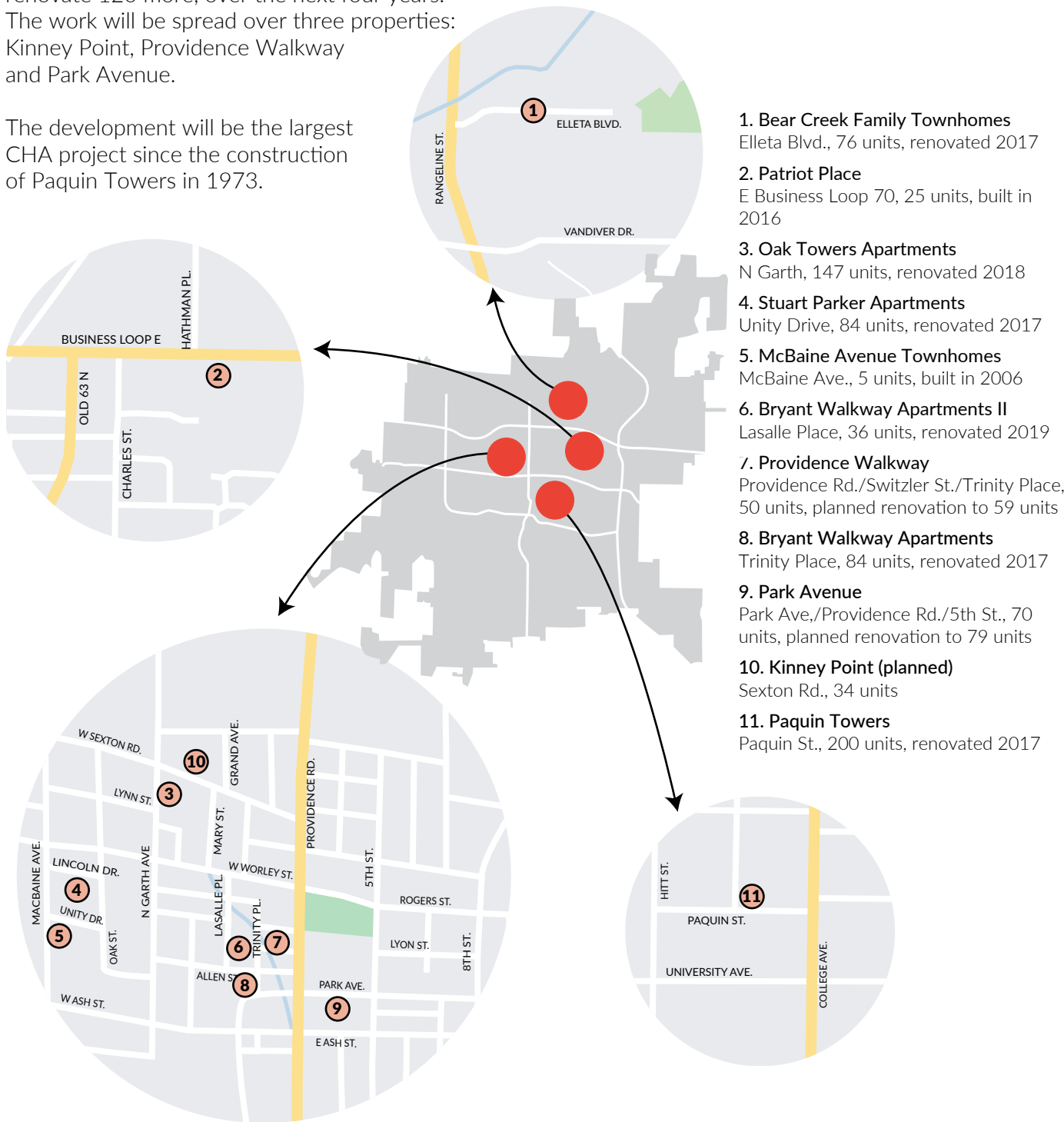


# Columbia Housing Authority properties

The Columbia Housing Authority, which owns and administrates over 700 units of low-income housing across the city hopes to add 52 additional units to its housing stock, and renovate 120 more, over the next four years.

The work will be spread over three properties: Kinney Point, Providence Walkway and Park Avenue.

The development will be the largest CHA project since the construction of Paquin Towers in 1973.
