

Boone County has options for offenders besides prison

Treatment court programs are a holistic alternative to incarceration — and they work.
Graduating from drug court can reduce recidivism by 40%.

TREATMENT COURT PROGRAMS

DRUG

Programs for nonviolent offenders who have been determined to require substance abuse treatment and have a minimal history of prior criminal convictions.

MENTAL HEALTH

Provides mental health and other services to people with mental illness who have been arrested for nonviolent offenses in Boone County.

VETERANS

Designed for veterans who have pleaded guilty to a criminal charge in Boone or Callaway counties and who are eligible to receive services from the Veterans Health Administration.

DWI

Comprehensive treatment programs for nonviolent offenders who have been determined to require substance abuse treatment and have a minimal history of prior criminal convictions.

FAMILY

Drug treatment program for parents who have a substance use disorder and have children in the juvenile court system.
