March 12
NCAA cancels winter and spring championships.



March 17
SEC cancels spring sports.



March 11, 2020
First round of SEC men's basketball tournament is played. SEC canceled the rest of the tournament the following morning.



March 16
MSHSAA cancels Class 4 and 5 basketball championships. Classes 1-3 played the weekend prior. NAIA cancels spring sports.



April 9
MSHSAA cancels spring championships.



Sept. 17
Battle high school football puts season on hold until Oct. 2.



Dec. 27
Music City Bowl canceled.



Sept. 4
MU hosts first event of 2020-21 school year with football's loss to Alabama.

Sept. 30
Stephens College opts out of fall season.

October/November
Missouri football has four games postponed.

Jan. 8, 2021
Missouri men's basketball takes COVID-19 pause. Women's basketball takes one two days later.
