Dear Distinguished Leader,

It is with sincere regret that I must notify you that Northwest Medical Isotopes LLC is forced to discontinue our efforts to build a Processing facility on the University of Missouri land and to utilize the University of Missouri Research Reactor to produce isotopes for us.

I can't say if it was because of the effect of the pandemic on the economy, the wildfires on the west coast or just fate - but circumstances presented that did not allow us to continue our efforts in Columbia and out of respect to our partners and others we had to discontinue operations. I can say that Dr. Robertson and his staff helped us work through this difficult decision and we would not hesitate to work with them and their colleagues in the future. They are exceptional professionals who serve all of you well.

The other thing I would like to comment on is how impressed we were with all of you and your community. It was evident throughout this process how much you care for your community and benefit them by your involvement and leadership.

Our plans for the future are to return to our operations in Oregon, take many of the lessons learned from our time with all of you and see if we can't find a path forward that serves our investors and ultimately, the patients we hoped to serve.
