## **Internal Review of Calls for Service, Incident Reports, including recordings related to Sandra Marisol Fuentes Huaracha and Michael Gleason Jr.**

**Completed: October 28, 2025**

**Released: May 15, 2026**

### **PURPOSE:**

The Purpose of this document is to review the calls for service in reference to the Sandra Marisol Fuentes Huaracha (Fuentes) homicide and subsequent suicide of Michael Gleason Jr. (Gleason). The review will identify areas for improvement within the Berlin Police Department (BPD) in reference to the response to these incidents and others in the future. Secondly, this review hopes to foster open dialogue and transparency with the citizens that the department serves.

This review will report on the action or inaction of the Berlin Police Department when it relates to the events leading up to the Fuentes homicide and Michael Gleason (Gleason) suicide. This document does not endeavor to point out the failures or weaknesses of other departments, agencies or systems associated with the matter. This review will also not comment on the status or outcome of any personnel-related matters associated with information contained within.

This document is in chronological order of when calls were received by the Berlin Police Department after the arrest of Gleason for Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, Kidnapping and Theft. The calls have been redacted for privacy concerns and are attached as addendums to this report.

The review was completed by department personnel as part of an internal review and associated internal investigations. BPD personnel conducted a review of all calls for services involving Fuentes and Gleason from April 26, 2025 through July 6, 2025. This

included the viewing of body camera footage and recorded telephone calls to determine adequate or inadequate responses by employees within the Berlin Police Department.

### **BACKGROUND**

On April 25, 2025, Fuentes reported to Officer Joshua Cusson of the Berlin Police Department that her husband, Gleason, had allegedly sexually assaulted her, committed kidnapping and the theft of \$8000.00 in US Currency from her. Due to the allegations, an investigation was started, and the Lethality Assessment Program form was completed with Fuentes. When asked by Officer Cusson, Fuentes chose not to call Response to Domestic and Sexual Violence while at the police department. It is unknown if she called at a later date. The BPD also assisted Fuentes in obtaining an Emergency Order of Protection. Gleason's firearms were seized by BPD Officers because of the Emergency Order of Protection. The matter was investigated, and an arrest warrant for Gleason was authorized on April 26, 2025 for the charges of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault, Kidnapping and Theft.

On April 26, 2025, members of the BPD arrested Gleason on that warrant after he tried to flee the area of his arrest. Gleason was ultimately held on \$5000.00 cash bail by Court Magistrate Stephanie Johnson.

The BPD prosecutor, Lt Zach Howry, had argued for the preventive detention of Gleason based upon the extremely serious charges against Gleason and the fact he had tried to flee during his arrest. Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault alone is an extremely egregious offense against a person which Lt. Howry used when arguing for preventative detention of Gleason.

On April 28, 2025, Lt. Howry again argued for preventative detention in the 1<sup>st</sup> Circuit Court-District Division-Berlin due to the major felony level criminal charges filed against Gleason and the fact that he had also tried to flee the scene of his arrest. The bail was set by Justice Janet Subers at \$5000.00 cash in the 1<sup>st</sup> Circuit Court-District Division-Berlin.

### **CALL FOR SERVICES RELATED TO FUENTES AND GLEASON**

#### **April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call For Service 25-7495 (Addendum 1) Incident Report 25-314-OF**

Fuentes called reporting items belonging to her that were missing from the residence. She reported that clothes, jewelry, paperwork, legal documents/identification items were missing. She believed people who knew Gleason went into the house while she was gone, prior to Gleason's arrest. Officers could not determine if the items missing happened prior to the arrest of Gleason and/or the service of the emergency protective order (Addendum 2) or the criminal bail order (Addendum 3).

When she called the BPD there were people on scene who were there to remove items for Gleason. The subjects on scene were spoken with, but the vehicle they were operating was not searched. Cpl. Benjamin Harmon also spoke with a female subject at her residence later investigating Fuentes's missing items. This subject's home was not searched as probable cause would have had to exist that the specific items missing were believed to be located at the residence. Cpl. Harmon forwarded the case to Detectives for 'deconfliction' with the original sexual assault felony case. This was reviewed by both detectives, and they determined there was no conflict. There were no further follow-ups or additions to the original report.

After a review of recorded telephone calls made by Gleason from the BPD booking room and the Coos County House of Corrections, Gleason had requested third parties to go the residence and remove items associated with his business and bank accounts. He also requested that the doors to the residence be locked. The review could not find any recorded telephone calls where Gleason requested subjects to remove the items that Fuentes had reported missing.

During one recorded call from the booking area, Gleason is cautioned by Sgt. Mike Pearson that Gleason/friends cannot have third-party contact with Fuentes while or in furtherance of obtaining his property due to the emergency protective order in effect at that time of the call.

Gleason's calls from the BPD booking room on April 26<sup>th</sup> occur before the bail conditions set by Magistrate Stephanie Johnson on April 27, 2025. These bail conditions had required Gleason to obtain a police civil standby to retrieve personal belongings and items associated with the business.

**April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-7560 (Addendum 4).**

Officer Madisyn Buteau served the temporary order of protection to Gleason. A review of the body camera footage detailed that Officer Buteau read the order to Gleason word for word. Sgt. Dennis Gale also served Gleason a motion for property return from Fuentes. Gleason claimed to officers that he had none of the property Fuentes was seeking.

**April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call For Service 25-7577 (Addendum 5).**

Fuentes asked about retrieving her phone or pictures from her phone of personal documents. During this encounter she was also requested to write a statement by Officer Joshua Herrmann about personal property that was missing. This written statement was in reference to the alleged thefts reported in CFS 2025-7495 on April 27, 2025.

The BPD was unable to comply with her request to retrieve her phone and pictures as the phone was of evidentiary value for the pending felony charges against Gleason. The phone had already been entered into evidence to protect the integrity of the initial sexual assault investigation reported on April 25, 2025. Any manipulation of the phone could have affected the admissibility of evidence contained on the phone that investigators had not discovered yet.

**April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Call for Service 25-7637 (Addendum 6).**

Fuentes and her friends located some firearm magazines and rounds that were found in a container unit at the Hillside Avenue property. These items were recovered by Ofc. Spencer Fitzgerald. Fuentes and associates again mention items such as car keys, documents and papers that she still didn't have in her possession. They also asked to have a black Camaro in the driveway to be searched for weapons. It was later determined to be owned by Gleason and used by his daughter Alysia Gleason. It was locked at the time.

While there Fuentes found a purse belonging to her in an outdoor trash can. They said it was related to CFS 25-7495. They brought up other issues related to Gleason's friends that had come to the house without her permission. The question officers faced was ultimately, is it a violation of the order for Gleason to have people go to the residence to get his property as long as he was not having third party contact with Fuentes. The Officers determined that it was not a violation. This call is related later to 25-482-OF.

**April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-7715 (Addendum 7).**

Fuentes came into the BPD lobby with mail for Gleason. Dispatch later returned it to a friend of Gleason.

**May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-7768 (Addendum 8).**

An attempt at a civil standby that didn't happen. Fuentes found a magazine for a gun, and a hunting license, which she gave to Ofc. Jonathan Oliveira.

**May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-8215 (Addendum 9) and 2025-8256 (Addendum 10). 25-348-OF.**

Fuentes called reference to cars that were removed from the property on Hillside Avenue. Officer Fitzgerald learns through his investigation that Gleason contacted a towing company to remove the two vehicles as they are owned by Gleason. Ofc. Fitzgerald's report reflects an interview with Fuentes where she said that Gleason owned the vehicles, purchased them before they were married and they were used by Gleason's daughter Alysia, and that Fuentes did not use them. Officers determined it was not a violation of the

order as, according to police reports, Fuentes claimed to not have an equitable interest in the missing vehicles and no contact by Gleason was reported by Fuentes.

It should be noted that a review of the Temporary Order of Protection (Addendum 11) dated 4/28/2025 gave temporary and exclusive use of only a 2011 Camaro to Fuentes. GLEASON at the time of the investigation had a 2015 Chevrolet Camaro registered to him. A later call for service (2025-9079) identifies that Fuentes had the use of a Maine registered 2011 Chevrolet Camaro. The Camaro removed by Caron's towing was not the same Camaro the Temporary Order of Protection gave possession of to Fuentes.

**May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-8541 (Addendum 12).**

Gleason contacted the BPD by phone to attempt to set up a civil standby. BPD was unsuccessful in arranging this due to GLEASON not confirming time and date.

**May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-8709 (Addendum 13).**

Gleason called requesting a civil standby by phone. Officer Buteau was unable to reach Fuentes to set up a date and time.

**May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-8855 (Addendum 14).**

Gleason came to the BPD to drop off keys for Fuentes. Fuentes later picked them up from dispatch. No officer was assigned to this call for service.

**May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-9079 (Addendum 15).**

Fuentes reported that she had locked her keys in her 2011 Chevrolet Camaro. Cpl. Harmon responded and unlocked the vehicle.

**May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-9150 (Addendum 16).**

Gleason contacted the BPD requesting a civil standby to retrieve property. Officer Kenneth Lavoie contacted Fuentes. The call for service reflects that Fuentes would contact the BPD when she had a date and time that this could occur.

**May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-9202 (Addendum 17).**

Gleason contacted the BPD to request a civil standby to retrieve property. Fuentes was contacted and advised that she would not be able to schedule a standby during that week.

**May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-9317 (Addendum 18).**

Fuentes and another person reported that a male subject was serving them subpoenas at La Casita wearing a GOPRO. They wanted to file and serve this subject with a no trespass letter for the restaurant. They were not happy that he went to the restaurant. They

mentioned this same subject was at the house back when the dispute of property was happening in April 2025.

Officer Cusson called the subject on May 23, 2025 and May 24, 2025. He was made aware of the paperwork. He was served the trespass letter prohibiting his entry into La Casita on June 4, 2025.

**May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-9538 (Addendum 19).**

Fuentes reported that Gleason was driving by her restaurant on Wight Street. The call for service states “not a violation” related to driving by the restaurant. She reported him driving by her house repeatedly, identified neighbors and coworkers who saw this as recent as two days prior.

Officer Joshua Herrmann was dispatched to this call. The call for service does not mention Gleason driving by the house. Officer Herrmann tells Fuentes, “He (Gleason) should not be driving by your house, if you see him, call us.” This was alleged to have occurred two days prior to the reporting.

There should have been an incident report taken for a Violation of a Protective Order by Officer Herrmann. The report by Fuentes should have been fully investigated to determine if there was probable cause to charge Gleason with violating the protective order by driving by the residence or her place of work. An incident report should have been requested by Officer Herrmann to determine if Gleason had violated the protective order by driving by the restaurant and/or residence. It was documented in the call for service that driving by the restaurant was not a violation. An incident report could have documented why it was not a violation in the officer’s opinion. The restraining order prohibited Gleason from being within 300 feet of Fuentes. The distance from the restaurant to where she alleged Gleason’s vehicle had driven is approximately 189 feet. This is well within the 300 feet prohibited by the Protective Order.

Since the reported driving by the residence violation was not documented in the call for service, a supervisory review of this call would not have flagged this situation or caused further investigation by a supervisor. This investigation required more investigation to determine if a violation of the Protective Order had occurred.

**June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10064 (Addendum 20). Incident 25-412-OF.**

Fuentes reported that she had learned Gleason sold a truck. The vehicle alleged to have been sold is the same vehicle that Fuentes claimed no equitable interest during the call for service on May 7, 2025 (25-8215). Officer Fitzgerald took a report, completed follow-ups, and interviews. The investigation was to determine if Gleason had sold a truck that Fuentes

had an equitable interest in. Officer Fitzgerald intended to pursue charges if probable cause existed. Gleason died prior to that being done. Officer Fitzgerald had completed his most recent follow-up to this case on June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

The investigation into the vehicle revealed that the vehicle reported sold by Fuentes had belonged to Gleason prior to the marriage. The main user of the vehicle in question was reported by Fuentes to be Alysia Gleason. The vehicle was registered to Michael Gleason only. Officer Fitzgerald's investigation discovered that the vehicle had been turned over to a local car dealership. The paperwork he eventually received during the investigation showed that a check had been issued to Gleason, but that the words no cash value were printed on the check and Officer Fitzgerald believed it could not be deposited by Gleason. Officer Fitzgerald also received documentation that listed it as a trade in/dealer swap.

Officer Fitzgerald had determined that this "check" could be used for a vehicle swap/purchase. Due to the above facts, Officer Fitzgerald at the time of the homicide was still attempting to determine if probable cause existed that there had been any equitable loss to Fuentes in violation of the protection order. He had requested the opinion of the prosecutor and/or an attorney as to whether Fuentes had suffered an equitable loss in the vehicle. He had not received an answer by the time the homicide of Fuentes occurred.

Fuentes also reported that her Instagram account had the username changed, a change in the bio, and followers were deleted. Fuentes believes Gleason did this as he had her account information. Fuentes no longer had access to the email or the phone number associated with the account. Due to this, she had received no notifications of any changes as to when or by whom the changes had occurred. Officer Fitzgerald asked her to contact him with more information if she was able to access her email. No information was received documenting whether the Instagram changes had been made before or after the order of Protection. There's no known record that she contacted the department again with the needed information related to her Instagram.

**June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10365 (Addendum 21).**

Fuentes found some ammunition in the storage container at the residence. The ammunition was given to Cpl. Adam Sperlonga. Fuentes also gave statement forms for Ofc. Fitzgerald in reference to 25-412-OF.

**June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10408 (Addendum 22).**

Gleason contacted the BPD to set up a civil standby. Officer Christopher Bowman reported to dispatch that he spoke to Fuentes and that lawyers were dealing with scheduling a civil standby.

**June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10413 (Addendum 23).**

Fuentes reporting on the Instagram account that Officer Fitzgerald was already following up on. It seems they provided some information related to a screenshot of an email address they said is Gleason's. They showed the screen shot to Ofc. Oliveira. Officer Fitzgerald had received screenshots from Fuentes during his investigation. Fuentes and a female subject reported 'five times' Gleason broke the DVO by sending people to the house and going there himself to remove property. They report that Gleason is committing identity theft by using her social media. Ofc. Oliveira said he'd ask Gleason about it. This information was relayed to Officer Fitzgerald as part of Officer Fitzgerald's investigation into the sold vehicle. Much of the information reported in this call is the same information that Fitzgerald was already investigating with Instagram and the sold truck. Officer Oliveira did not talk to Gleason, as it was Officer Fitzgerald's ongoing case. (Fitzgerald report 25-412-OF)

**June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10439 (Addendum 24) and 2025-10444 (Addendum 25).**

Fuentes spoke at length with Officer Cusson twice that evening at La Casita reference the Instagram issue again. They spoke about arranging the civil standby and repeated the issues surrounding the people going to the residence back from April.

**June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10554 (Addendum 26).**

Final arrangement of civil standby. Arranged by several officers with both parties agreeing on a time, and Gleason pays the fee at the PD.

**June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10582 (Addendum 27).**

Fuentes called because her dog was inside when she had left earlier. She came home and the dog was now outside. Nothing seemed disturbed or missing, no sign of forced entry, and no surveillance video. It was determined no further action could be taken. While there, Fuentes and friends again report the Instagram issue, and Gleason going on the property and taking things. But this is related again to the vehicles being removed by the towing company. They again report to Officer Cusson and Cpl. Beal about Gleason driving by the restaurant. Officer Fitzgerald was already investigating the Instagram report and removal of vehicles. The way Gleason's alleged actions of driving by the restaurant were reported to Officer Cusson and Cpl. Beal would have led them to believe another officer was already investigating the issue reported to them. However, Officer Herrmann had not taken an incident report on that information.

**June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10625 (Addendum 28).**

This call for service consists of Officer Fitzgerald at a civil standby. Gleason and another male were there wearing Go Pros on their chests. Fuentes and friends are there also. Gleason gave the officer some magazines and Tannerite that he found while moving stuff out. Gleason asks the officer during the standby to relay his questions about property to Fuentes. Gleason records the house with a cell phone. One of Fuentes's friends records Gleason.

**June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10651 (Addendum, 29).**

Gleason called the police department to report that he was leaving a trailer at a friend's house located at 518 Hillside Avenue in Berlin. He self-reported it was over 300 feet away from where Fuentes was living. Gleason then called when he was done. A search revealed the two houses are approximately 351 feet apart.

**June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-10696 (Addendum 30).**

Gleason reported that Fuentes' friends said there was a 'break in', which is why some of his property was missing. Fuentes had never reported a break-in to the BPD. She did report her dog being let out while she was not home. It is unclear if the original late April removal of property around the time of Gleason's arrest (ref: 25-314-OF) or the report involving the dog (25-10582) was the catalyst of the comment that Gleason had received. Gleason was told to request the records by Officer Fitzgerald. At the time of death, Gleason had not received from the records division what he was requesting. He was still under the impression there had been a break-in. Incident Report 25-482-OF

**June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-11071 (Addendum 31).**

This call for service documented that Fuentes was meeting with Officer Fitzgerald for an interview in reference to 25-412-OF (Sold vehicle report/Instagram). The information received was documented as part of Officer Fitzgerald's report 25-412-OF.

**June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-11236 (Addendum 32).**

Fuentes had requested records from the BPD by filling out a records request form on June 11, 2025. Some of the requested records could not be released as they were part of open/ongoing criminal investigations. The documents that were available for release were provided to Fuentes.

**June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-11308 (Addendum 33).**

Fuentes providing more information to Officer Fitzgerald ref: 25-412-OF. Fuentes asked about a bow being returned to her. When Gleason's firearms were removed through a court order (Emergency Restraining Order), the officers also removed a bow and arrow. All the

items were logged into evidence at the police department including the bow. Fuentes was looking to have the bow returned to her. It is normal BPD procedure that a court order would have been required to release the bow to Fuentes as the bow had been seized under a court order (Emergency Restraining Order).

**June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-11733 (Addendum 34).**

This call for service documents Officer Fitzgerald picking up information from a local car dealership reference to Incident Report 25-412-OF. The dealership had not returned Officer Fitzgerald's phone call the previous week and he went to the dealership in person. The requested information was then provided to Officer Fitzgerald.

**June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-11748 (Addendum 35).**

Fuentes called the BPD after she was advised that a police officer had gone to her place of employment. This was determined to not have been a BPD officer. Fuentes was told to check with the Coos County Sheriff's Office.

**June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-11773 (Addendum 36).**

Gleason reported a stolen skid steer. Fuentes had allowed a neighbor on Winter Street to use the skid steer. Officer Rebecca Latham took report 25-465-OF. No action was taken from the investigation by Officer Latham. It was determined that Gleason could not trespass the neighbor from the property as Fuentes could allow him to enter, and furthermore Fuentes could allow him to use the skid steer. Officer Latham asked about how GLEASON had video of the neighbor using the skid steer. Gleason responded, "It doesn't matter how I got it. I lived there for 18 years, my neighbor looking out." Officer Latham spoke to Fuentes after her contact with Gleason. She advised Fuentes that Gleason had seen this happen. It was unknown if this occurred by the home's security cameras or a neighbor as Gleason had suggested. Gleason never provided the video/photo to Officer Latham. (The statements made by Gleason would readily lead the officer to believe that it was neighbors who reported and/or provided video to Gleason of the neighbor's use of skid steer).

**June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Call for Service 25-12029 (Addendum 37).**

This call for service was a report by Gleason of a Gorham police officer who follows Fuentes's Snapchat. Gleason reported this officer is now 'stalking' Gleason's Snapchat and talking badly about him. Gleason stated that he has a friend who did a ride along with the Gorham Police Department. The Gorham police officer "ran his mouth" talking to the ride along, specifically talking bad about Gleason to the ride along. Gleason also

complains that “some officers here are talking” (meaning BPD), and “things aren’t being handled 100%.”

Gleason also brought up an ex-boyfriend of Fuentes and knew the subject’s history with Fuentes. Gleason also accused Fuentes of covering the ex-boyfriend’s cameras and stealing the ex-boyfriend’s documents. Also, Gleason was still reporting missing items he believed Fuentes stole or gave away. Gleason spoke to Officer Fitzgerald. In this conversation Gleason alluded to knowing what vehicle Fuentes drove and when she had stopped driving a certain vehicle. He also stated that Fuentes isn’t living in the house. He also talks about the video showing the fire department, the officer, an officer with a clipboard at the house when they removed his guns. Gleason provided a statement to Officer Fitzgerald with a list of property he is missing. Gleason confirmed he knew, through Alysia, that it was a Sheriff looking to deliver paperwork to Fuentes in reference to 25-11748.

**July 4, 2025. Call for Service 25-12508 (Addendum 38).**

On July 4, 2025, at 6:25 AM, the Carroll County Sheriff’s Office (CCSO) received a phone call from an individual who identified himself as Walter Marchisio. The call concerned Gleason, who the caller identified as a friend who lives or lived in Berlin. The call was on a recorded line. Marchisio expressed concern for Gleason and how he was going through some rocky times with his wife, Fuentes. The caller mentioned he allowed Gleason to store his truck and trailer at his residence. He knew Gleason had a rental vehicle but wasn’t sure of the make and model. He wasn’t sure if he was in Berlin or not. Marchisio added Gleason wasn’t in the right frame of mind due to getting kicked out of his own house and a divorce filing. He tried talking to him and said that Gleason had thought about killing himself and harming her also. Marchisio added Gleason rented a vehicle to take off for a week and because Gleason didn’t trust his current truck. Gleason thought there was something wrong with it and he “just wanted to get out of here.” Marchisio wasn’t sure what Gleason was going to do but he didn’t want to see him do something stupid. Marchisio was aware that there were 2 protective/restraining orders on Gleason but wasn’t sure if he had any weapons. He wasn’t sure where Gleason was staying in Berlin but based on what he knew, he felt like he could cause harm to himself or Marisol. The call to the Carroll County Sheriff’s Office was less than 6 minutes.

On July 4, 2025, CCSO Dispatch contacted the BPD Dispatch regarding the call received from Marchisio. The CCSO dispatch mentioned that Gleason needed to be “talked off a cliff” a few times in recent days by Marchisio. Gleason also told Marchisio that he married a Mexican woman about 8 months ago and “they were going through it”. Marchisio mentioned that Gleason said he “should kill himself and take her out with him.” Marchisio

reported that Gleason had come to his Ossipee home on July 3, 2025, in a pickup truck with a trailer attached. Marchisio thought it was odd that Gleason requested that he keep his truck and trailer at Marchisio's home. Gleason also requested that Marchisio provide him with a ride to a car rental company in Somersworth. CCSO mentioned that the soon to be ex-wife probably lived in Berlin. There was a general understanding with officers that the woman was Fuentes. Marchisio told the CCSO that Gleason is not in a good state of mind.

BPD Dispatcher Crystal Wallace reported the information to Cpl. Jarod Beal for follow-up. Dispatcher Wallace provided Cpl. Beal with Marchisio's telephone number. An investigation into the handling of this call determined the following. Cpl. Beal called Gleason. Cpl. Beal's conversation with Gleason lasted approximately one minute and fourteen seconds. During the call, Gleason denied knowing Marchisio and denied needing any assistance. No other investigation or calls were conducted in reference to this call.

An internal investigation conducted by the Berlin Police Department revealed that on July 5, 2025, Dispatcher Wallace expressed concern to Officer Cusson on how the call for service (2025-12508) had been handled the previous day.

No other action was taken by the BPD on this call for service prior to the July 6, 2025, murder of Fuentes and suicide of Gleason.

#### **CONCLUSIONS:**

After review of all above noted calls for service and incident reports investigated at the Berlin Police Department in regard to Fuentes and Gleason; The following is noted:

-Officers provided a response each time there was a call from Fuentes, whether in person, in the lobby, or over the phone.

-In regard to incident 25-314-OF, more follow-up could have occurred relative to who had gone into the home, and what if any property of Fuentes had been removed. More follow-up may have determined when these items went missing. Did they go missing prior to Gleason's arrest or after his arrest? The case was referred to the Detective division for "deconfliction." It was found there was no conflict, but no further action was taken. It would have been appropriate for the officer to follow up with the parties involved for further statements or information. Gleason in future contact would deny knowledge of where the items in question were located. Gleason's incarcerated jail calls do not suggest that he requested the items to be taken after he had been arrested.

-The reported violation of the protective order relative to the two vehicles removed by the towing company (25-348-OF) was properly investigated and appropriately no charges were brought forward. Officers determined there was no probable cause that Gleason had

violated the protective order. The vehicles were noted as being owned prior to marriage and registered solely to Michael Gleason, but intended for the use of his daughter, Alysia Gleason, who was a resident of the home.

-The reported violation of the protective order relative to the vehicle sold to a local car dealership (25-412-OF) was being properly investigated as well. Officer Fitzgerald was actively conducting interviews and follow-ups and was preparing the case for a potential charge. When reported, this was not a violation of the protective order that would have allowed for a 12 hour stop and arrest by statute. There was follow-up that needed to be conducted to establish probable cause, and this was being done. Officer Fitzgerald was attempting to establish probable cause that Fuentes had suffered an equitable loss thus resulting in the violation of the protective order.

-The reported violation of the protective order relative to the Instagram account, 25-412-OF, was properly investigated as well. In review of the evidence provided, it did not appear to officers that what was being alleged fell under any specific section that violated the order of protection in this case. Nor did officers receive or discover any evidence of when the changes had been made. The reported actions did not violate the identity theft statutes. No financial loss or information suggesting someone was actively posing as Fuentes is known to have been reported by Fuentes in relation to her Instagram account.

-The reported violation of the protective order relative to Gleason driving past the restaurant and home of Marisol Fuentes was not properly investigated by Officer Herrmann. An incident should have been initiated. Interviews and statements from witnesses should have been sought. Then a decision should have been made as to whether probable cause existed that a violation of a protective order offense had been committed by Gleason. This did not occur nor was the reported alleged offense documented fully in the call for service.

-The July 4<sup>th</sup> welfare check call for service (25-12508) was not handled appropriately or properly. This is a glaring failure of basic police functions and basic criminal investigation. No other form of intervention was tried or attempted by any BPD officers.

1. Marchisio was not attempted to be contacted.
2. Marchisio was not questioned as to whether he would participate in the Involuntary Emergency Admission process for Gleason.
3. No attempt was made to determine Gleason's location.
4. No attempt was made to do an in-person interview with Gleason.
5. No call was made or attempted to check on the welfare of Fuentes at that time.

6. Fuentes was not contacted to warn her of the possible homicidal comments attributed by Marchisio to Gleason.

-All other calls in this report that aren't specifically mentioned in the above conclusion appeared to have been handled appropriately as would be expected by the average responding patrol officer.

-There are further calls related to Gleason and a second alleged victim. These calls resulted in the service of a second protective order against Gleason within days of the homicide of Fuentes. These calls are not associated with Fuentes.

#### **NOTES:**

-Several times during police interaction, Fuentes had asked about retrieving her phone, she was told the phone was in evidence. This was appropriate as the phone had been in Gleason's possession at the time of his arrest. The phone was corroborating evidence to Fuentes's statement of the sexual assault, kidnapping and theft charges. The phone would not have been able to be released at that time.

-The review also concluded that no evidence was found that photographic or video proof of Gleason violating the protective was ever shown or provided to any BPD officers prior to the murder of Fuentes.

-The Berlin Police Department, at the time of the July 4<sup>th</sup> welfare check, did not have a specific policy detailing the proper response to welfare checks. A welfare check is considered one of the most basic police functions. It requires an officer to confirm or dispel a report that someone may be in danger of harm. Officers have a duty to ensure someone's safety when there is a report of possible danger to anyone involved in the report. A welfare check is part of an officer's community caretaking function, another basic police duty. There is a common sense understanding of the minimum steps that should be taken in a welfare check to include contacting the reporting party and notifying the subjects reported to be in danger if warranted by the information received.

-The review concluded that there is a need for legislation to add social media access/cyberspace to the Protective Order language. This would prevent a defendant of an order from accessing social media accounts whether they were previously personal or shared accounts of either the defendant or petitioner.

#### **ACTION ITEMS:**

1. The review of the handling of this matter highlighted the need for continued training by BPD officers and dispatchers in the following areas:
  - a. Response to Domestic Violence calls

- b. Victim trauma response training
  - c. Increased documentation in calls for service records.
- 2. Enact a policy of a supervisor review of all Domestic Violence related calls for service.
- 3. Conduct a policy review to determine if current policies are up to date to help guide officers in handling and responding to situations they may face.
- 4. Empowering dispatchers and all officers intervening when the outcome of a call needs more attention.
- 5. Consultation on bail hearings and probable cause hearings with the Coos County Attorney's Office on serious criminal offenses.
- 6. Supervisory review of any allegation of the Violation of a Protective Order.
- 7. A study of the daily briefing procedure at the department to determine if information is being passed effectively between officers.



It shall be unlawful for any person subject to a qualifying protection order to possess any firearm or ammunition in or affecting commerce; or to ship, transport or receive any firearm or ammunition which has been shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce. A qualifying court order is an order that was issued after a hearing of which the defendant received actual notice, and at which the defendant had an opportunity to participate; and includes a finding that such person represents a credible threat to the physical safety of an intimate partner or child of such person or intimate partner or child of such intimate partner or person, or engaging in other conduct that would place an intimate partner in reasonable fear of bodily injury to the partner or child; or by its terms explicitly prohibits the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical force against such intimate partner or child that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury. 18 U.S.C. § 922 (g) (8).
4. It shall be unlawful for any person convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to ship, transport in interstate commerce, or possess in or affecting commerce, any firearm or ammunition; or to receive any firearm or ammunition which has been shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce. 18 U.S.C. § 922 (g) (9).
