1 DISPATCHER: 911. Where is your
2 emergency?

3 CALLER: Hey, so, um, I spent the
4 night with one of my friends last night. And I
5 came home. I'm -- I just got home. And my mom,
6 she's been acting crazy these past couple of
7 weeks because she's been diagnosed with, uh --
8 or with, um -- what is it called? Some kind of
9 disease that makes you think thoughts that
10 really aren't real.

11 DISPATCHER: Okay.

12 CALLER: And she's just been acting
13 weird. And I get here, and I try to get inside
14 the house. And she's not letting me in. And
15 she's telling me to leave and stuff. And my
16 brother's in there with her. And I heard him
17 saying that he killed -- she killed dad or
18 something like that. And I'm really worried.

19 DISPATCHER: Okay. What is your
20 address?

21 CALLER: Uh, 2907 Lenox Drive.

22 DISPATCHER: Okay. And what is your
23 name?

1 CALLER: [REDACTED]

2 DISPATCHER: Okay. What's your mom's
3 name?

4 CALLER: Uh, Michelle Owens.

5 DISPATCHER: Okay. Is there any
6 weapons inside the house?

7 CALLER: Um, I think there is
8 actually. My mom purchased a pistol the other
9 day, so she's been carrying that around with
10 her.

11 DISPATCHER: Okay. We've got
12 officers on the way. I need you to stay on the
13 phone with me. Okay?

14 CALLER: Okay. Do I need to leave?

15 DISPATCHER: If you -- if you're --
16 if you feel safe enough to stay there, that's
17 fine. But if you want to go just to, you know,
18 a few doors down. If you --

19 CALLER: Okay.

20 DISPATCHER: -- want to go to the
21 intersection of Lenox and Duncansby Drive, I can
22 have an officer meet you there. Okay?

23 CALLER: All right.

1 DISPATCHER: Okay.

2 CALLER: Yeah, I'll just do that.

3 DISPATCHER: Okay. And how old is
4 your brother?

5 CALLER: My brother is seven.

6 DISPATCHER: Okay. And he said that
7 your mom killed your dad?

8 CALLER: Yeah, that's what he kept
9 saying.

10 DISPATCHER: Okay. And --

11 CALLER: And I was like, mom, did you
12 really kill dad? And she was like, no,
13 everything's okay. But I saw the look in her
14 face, and she looked worried. So, um --

15 DISPATCHER: Okay. We've got
16 officers on the way. Okay? If you could, meet
17 them at the intersection of Lenox and Duncansby.
18 Can you give me a description of what you're
19 wearing?

20 CALLER: Uh, I'm in a black Grand
21 Cherokee. I'm in a black, uh, tank top -- or
22 not a black tank top, a black short sleeve
23 hoodie.

1 DISPATCHER: Okay. An officer will
2 be there shortly. Okay?

3 CALLER: All right. Thank you.
