

Each year, the Food Bank of North Alabama supplies 15 million pounds of food to homeless shelters, food pantries, soup kitchens and children's programs across Morgan, Marshall, Limestone, Lawrence, Cullman, and six other counties in North Alabama. In addition to individual donations. they pick up food donations from over 80 local grocery stores five days a week. The program saves over 4 million pounds of food from going to waste in local landfills each year and instead uses this food to feed our region's most vulnerable citizens. The Food Bank of North Alabama partners with companies and churches to provide weekend meal kits to students who depend upon school meals and may go without when school is closed. The kits ensure children arrive at school on Monday morning ready to learn without the distraction of hunger. During the Summer, thousands of lowincome children across north Alabama miss the school meals they received during the school year. Summer Meal Programs ensure that low-income children continue to receive nutritious meals even when schools are not in session. The food bank plays a vital role in responding

to emergencies that impact our region, including tornadoes and floods. They supply emergency food and water to residents directly impacted by disasters.

The Food Bank of North Alabama's mission is to feed the hungry today and create solutions that will end hunger tomorrow. This is a two-tiered approach that first addresses the immediate needs of people at risk of hunger today. Then it addresses the root causes of hunger through local food initiatives that help farmers sell fruits and vegetables directly to schools, workplace cafeterias and grocery stores, also help families access fresh foods from farmers by promoting the use of SNAP (formerly Food Stamps) at farmers markets. to learn more go to https://www. foodbanknorthal.org
