
Last year marked our first-year competing, where our students faced 48 teams from across the southern region. Despite limited experience, Coleman Middle School held the number one position for much of the first round, and Leland School Park ranked ninth, an outstanding achievement for first-time competitors. This year, four teams have advanced, and our students are more confident and prepared than ever.

Through participation in our STEAM program (Science, Technology, Engineering, Agriculture, Arts, and Mathematics) students gain hands-on experience in drone technology, teamwork, problem-solving, and engineering. These opportunities expose them to real-world careers and help prepare them for success in high-demand STEM fields.
