Sanger ISD has made several posts on Facebook attempting to sway voters to vote "YES" on the 2026 Sanger ISD Bond. I believe they used scare tactics on their postings on the below dates:

March 24, 2026 post saying that Sanger ISD growth is already impacting classrooms with added pressure on classrooms, shared spaces, and daily operations.

March 26, 2026 post saying that growth is already impacting elementary schools, and that they will exceed capacity by 2029. They then stated that the bond would relieve overcrowding and help ensure students have the space they need to learn.

April 10, 2026 post stating that the current bus fleet is unable to meet state safety requirements, and that the bond will purchase new buses to safely transport students.

April 14, 2026 post stating that the current Metal Fabrication Center makes it difficult to offer their program in a safe environment, and that the new bond will upgrade the center with modern systems and finishes to provide students with a safe environment.

Additionally, on April 13, 2026, the school called all Senior students out of class to give them a presentation on the Sanger ISD Bond, stating that they were 18 and needed to think about the future generations of Sanger ISD. I was not present during the presentation, but students are reporting that they felt the presentation was an attempt to try to get them to vote yes.
