Troy Mac Hohenberger, former Fire Chief of the Argyle Volunteer Fire District, pleaded guilty to federal charges today at the U.S. Courthouse – Sherman Division in Plano, Texas before U.S. Magistrate Judge Kimberly C. Priest Johnson.

This plea stems from an investigation and subsequent arrest by the Federal Bureau of Investigation on November 17th, 2022. The 13-count indictment charged Hohenberger with multiple federal violations related to misuse and theft of funds from the Argyle Fire District, Inc., along with making false statements to the Department of Labor.

Throughout the last six months, the emergency services provided by the firefighters, paramedics, and emergency medical technicians of the Denton County ESD No. 1 remained steadfast as they continue to deliver excellent service to the citizens of our community.

The Denton County ESD No. 1 is committed to supporting the personnel impacted by these allegations as the federal court administers this case and subsequent plea.
