PROTECTIVE ORDER	

The Court has been made aware of facts showing inadvertent disclosure by court clerk staff of several Suppressed and/or Sealed court filings to the Denver Gazette and/or its agents/employees.

The Court understands the Denver Gazette is aware these filings contain excerpts of materials that this Court has standing orders for, sealing the contents from public access.

The Court finds that disclosure of those materials to the public would endanger the state's interests in 1) grand jury secrecy, and 2) Defendants' rights to a fair trial and impartial jury. The Court finds that this Protective Order is the

least restrictive means of preventing great and certain harm to those state interests of the highest order. THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The Denver Gazette and its agents, employees, and assigns shall delete and destroy any copies of the Suppressed and/or Sealed materials they obtained from the court file.
- 2. The Denver Gazette and its agents, employees, and assigns shall not reveal any contents of the Suppressed and/or Sealed materials they obtained from the court file to any other person or entity.
