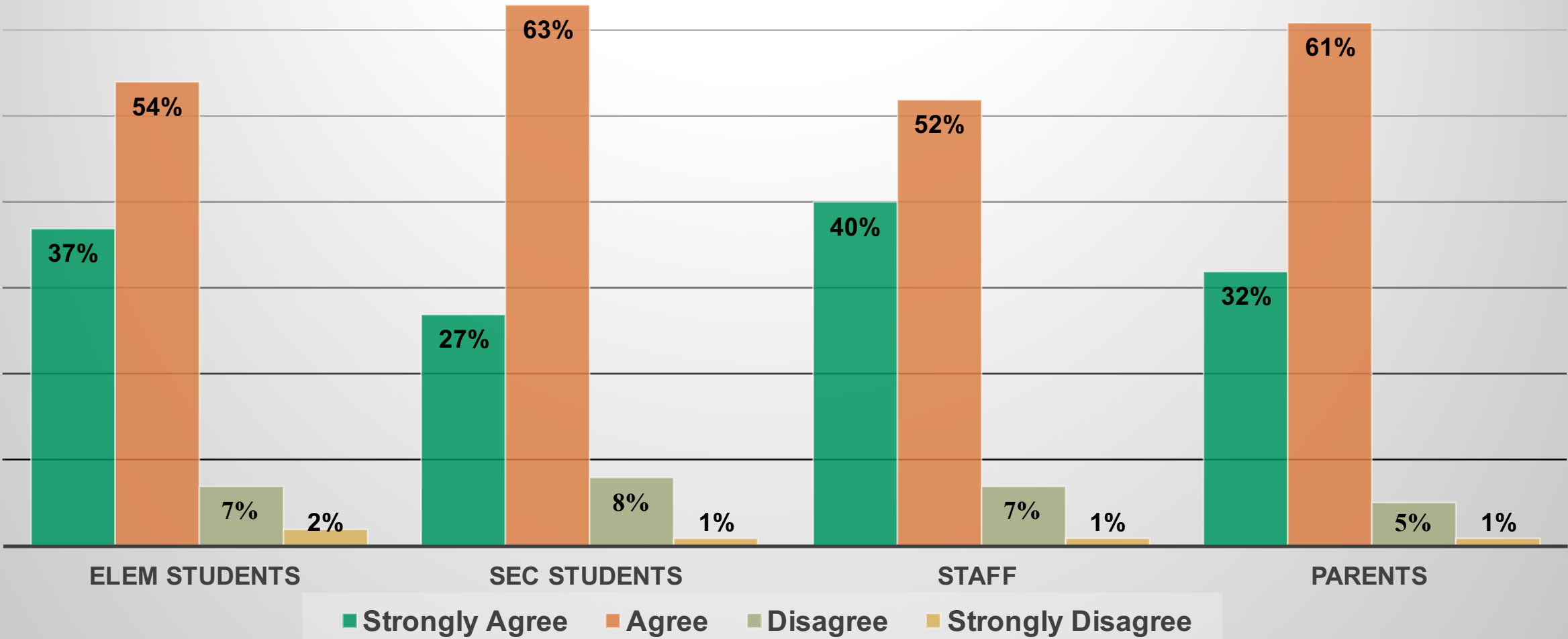

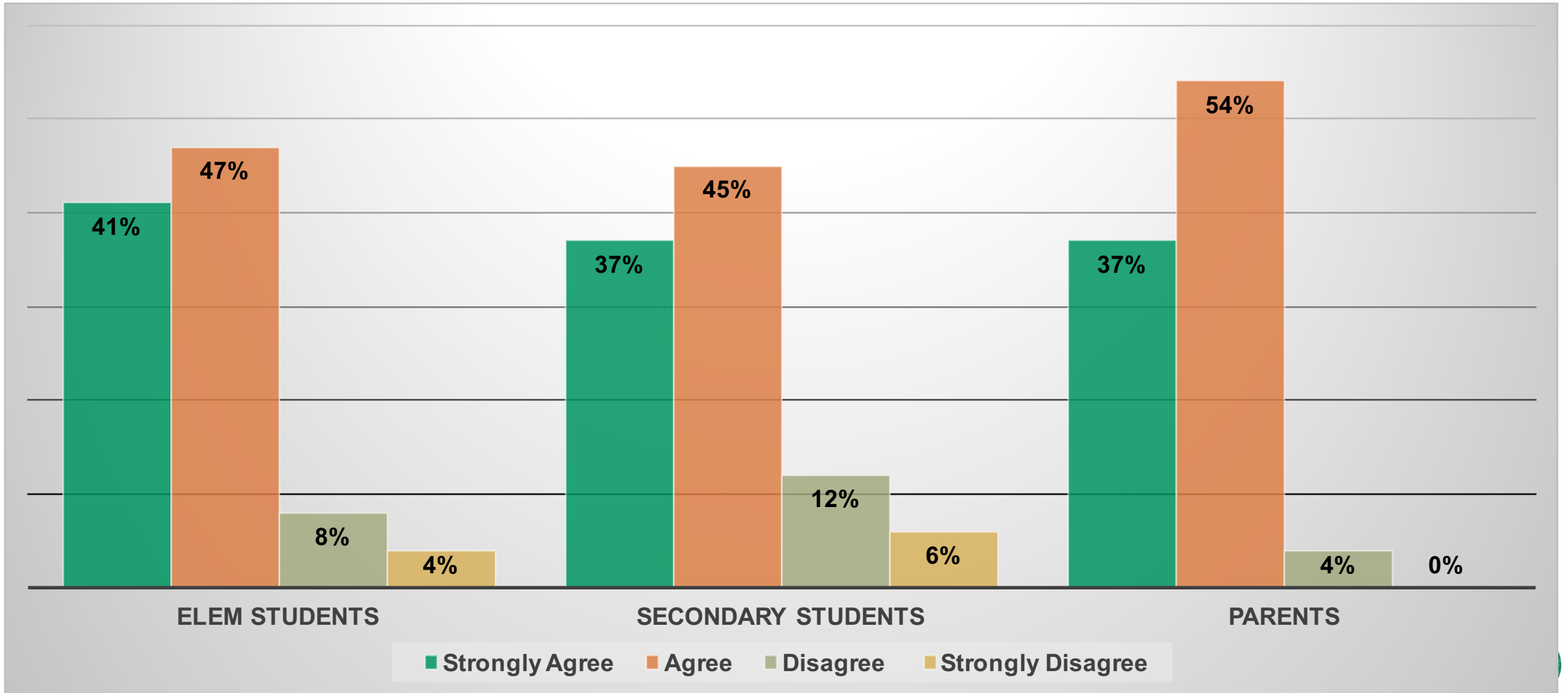

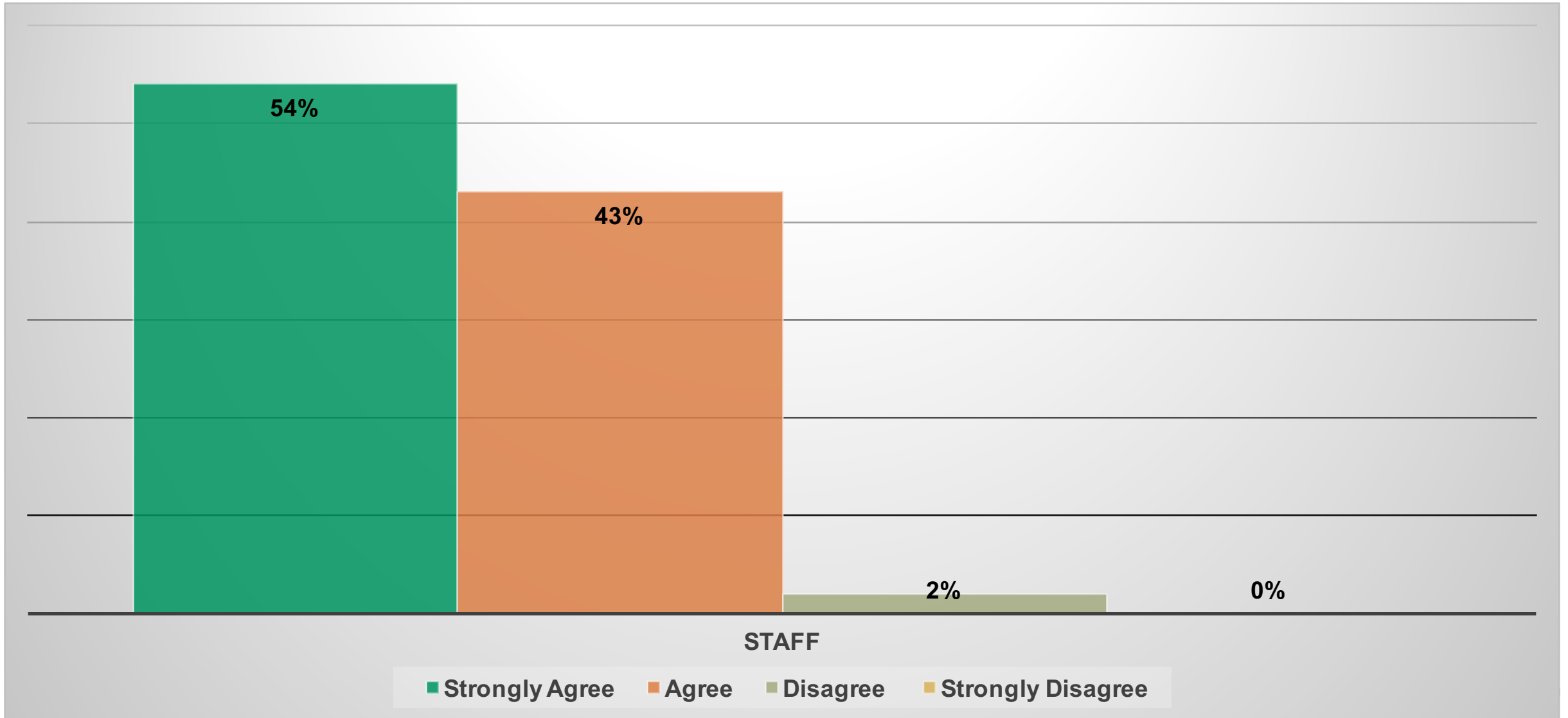
I feel safe at school



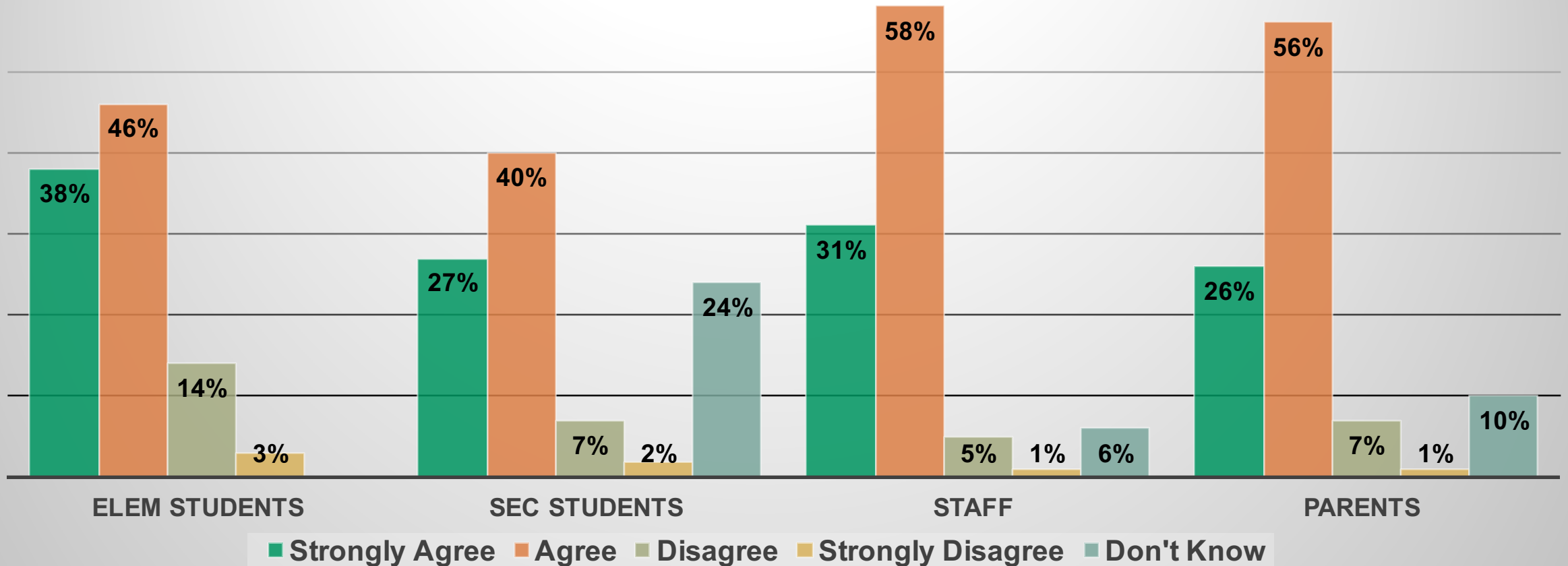
I feel there is someone at school I can talk to



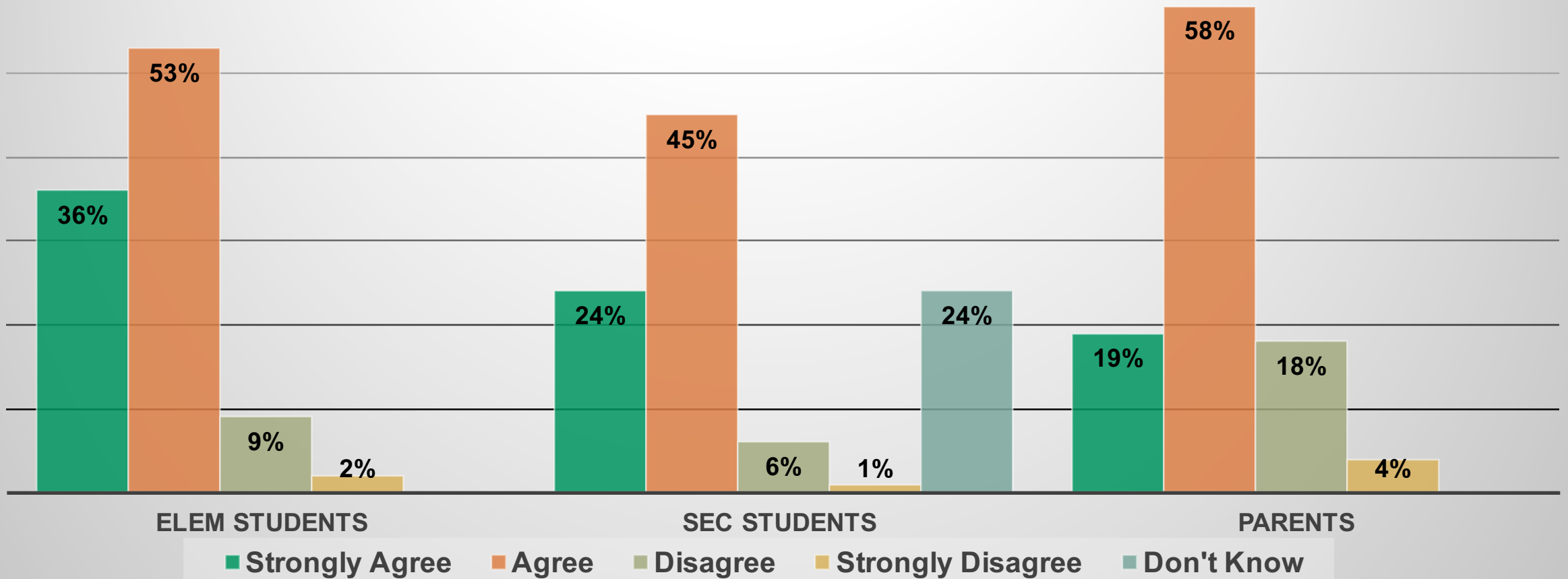
I am available to hear concerns



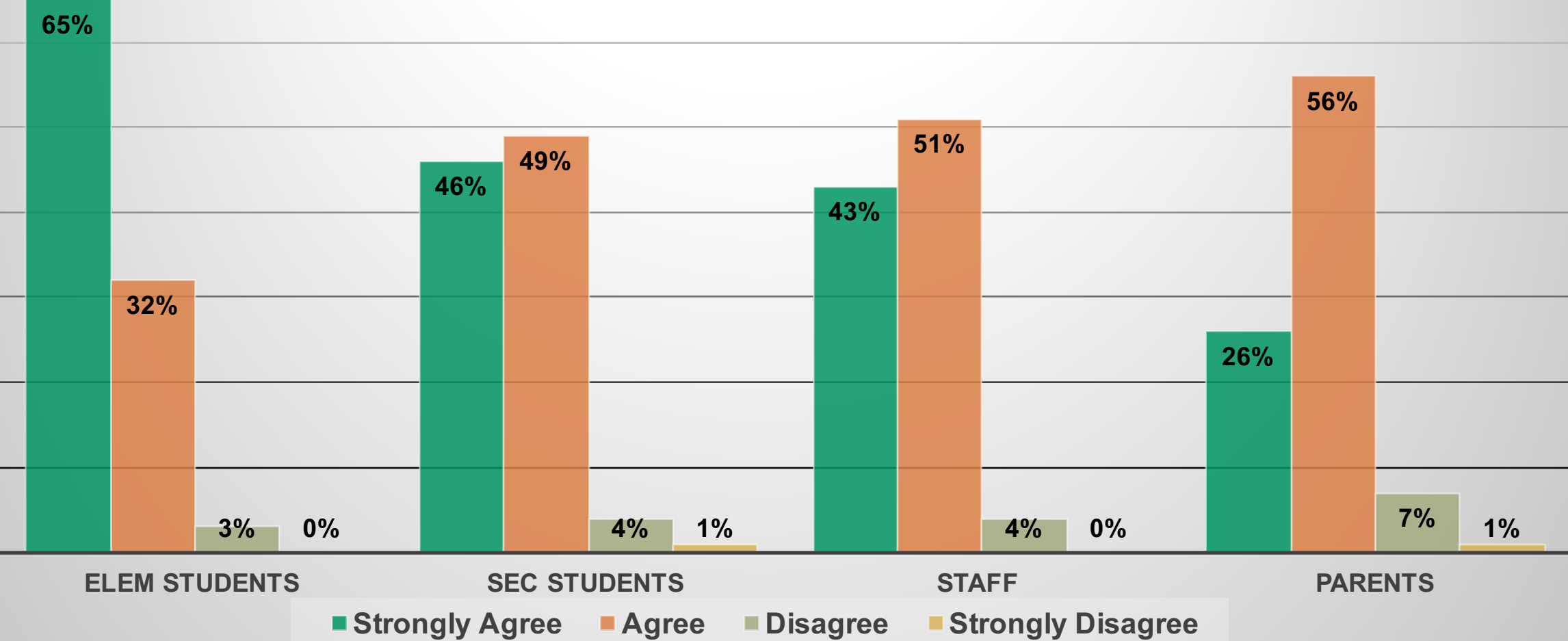
I feel safe at school functions or sporting events



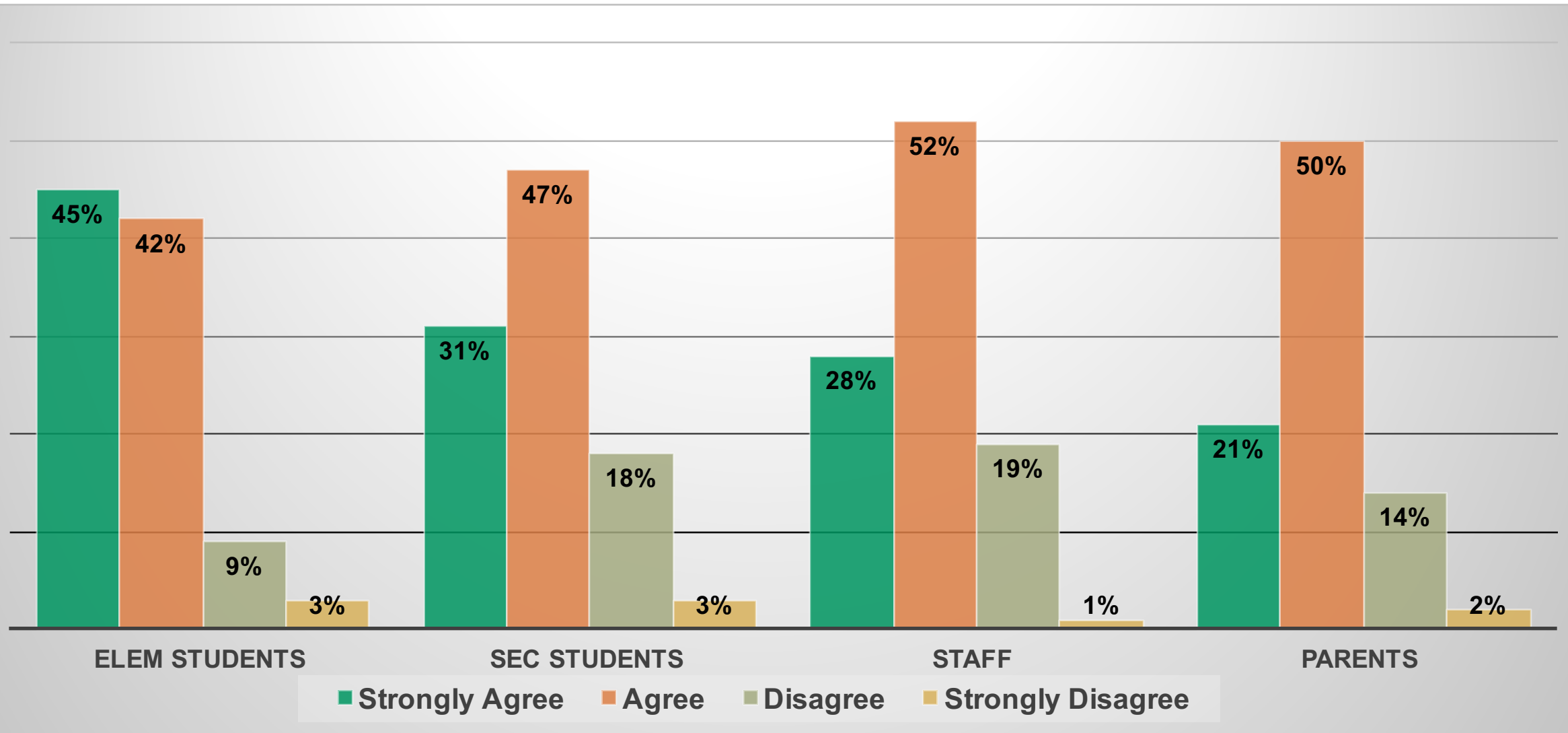
I feel safe after school (dismissal)



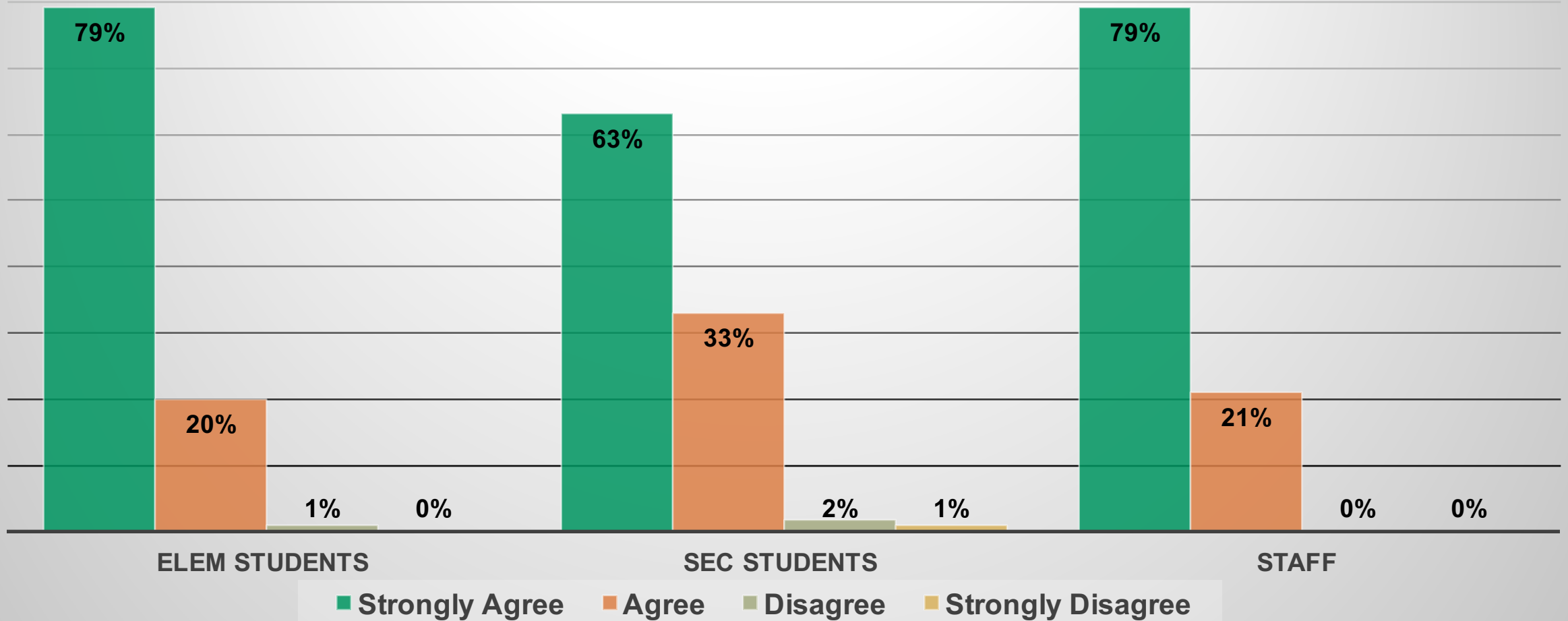
I know what to do in an emergency in class



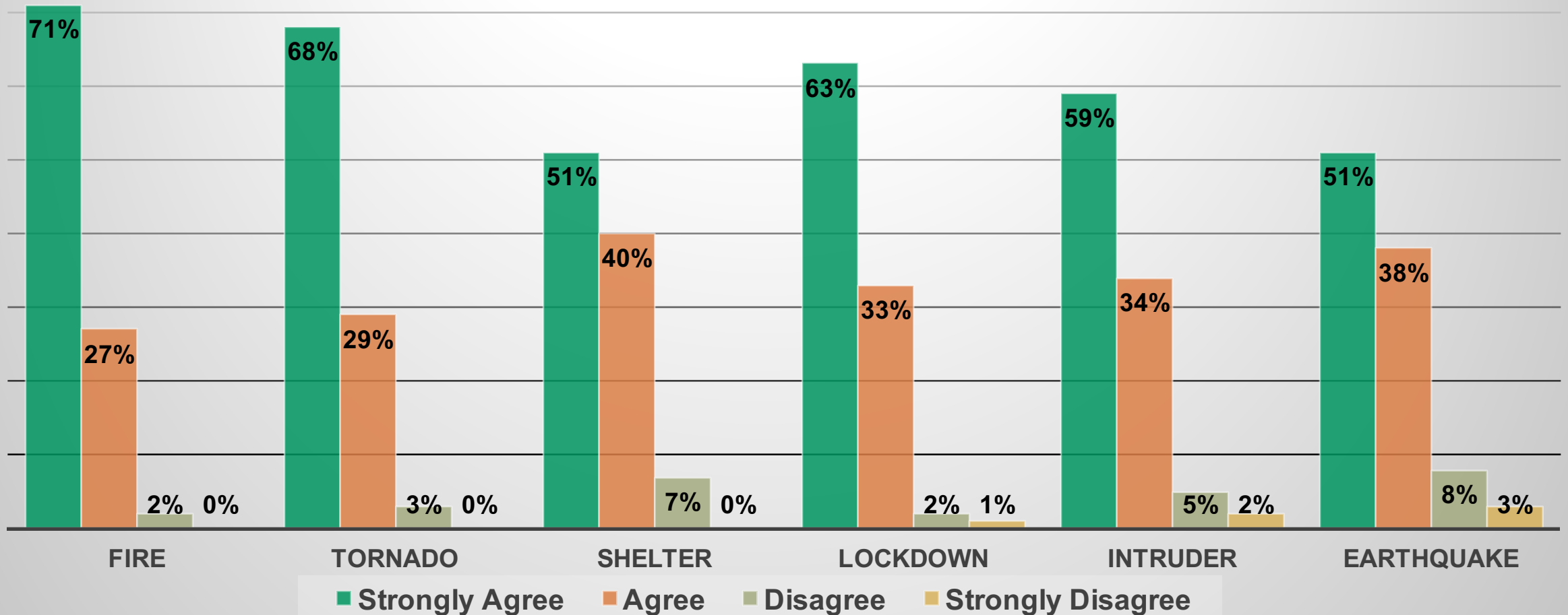
I know what to do in an emergency elsewhere in the school



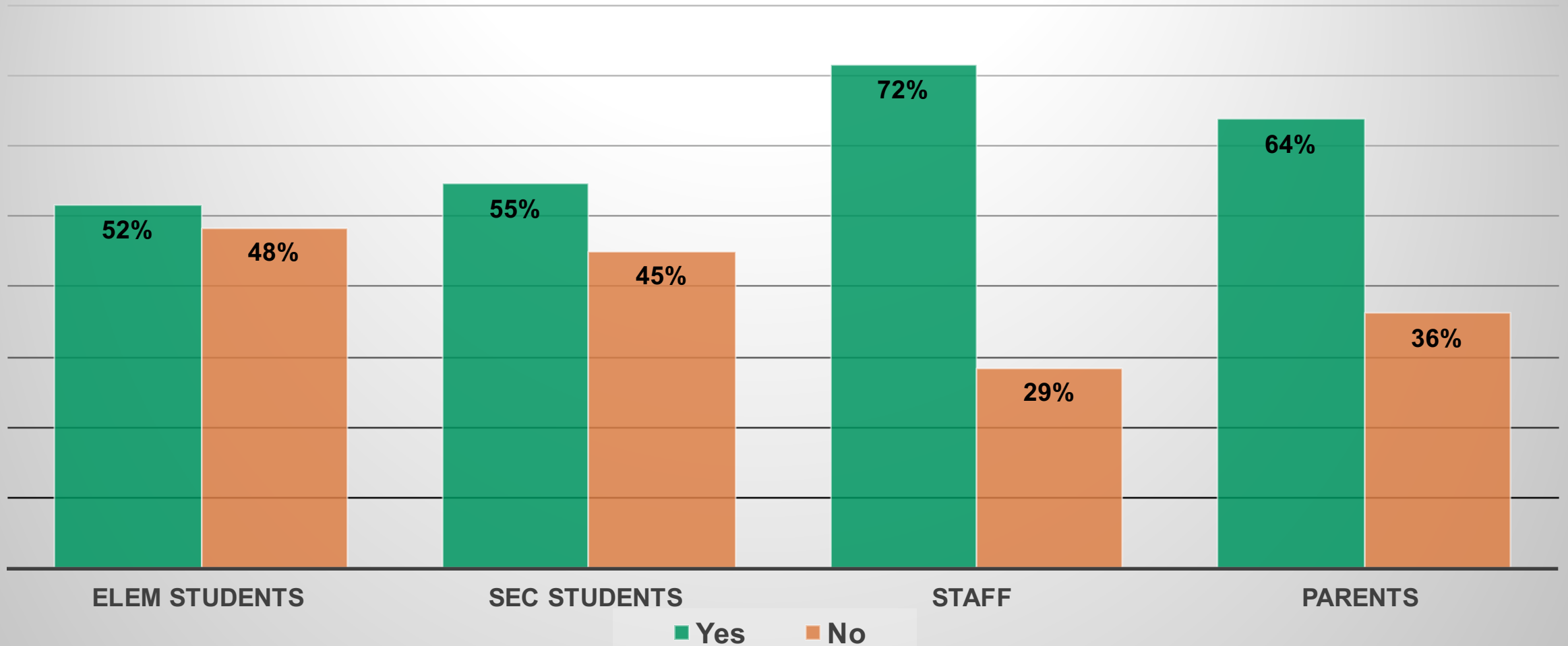

What should be the top priorities for 2018-2019?

Most Common Parent Responses

- Background Check for Staff and Volunteers – 10%
- Stop Bullying – 10%
- Secure Building/Keep Doors Locked – 9%
- Back Ground Checks for Visitors – 9%
- Better Traffic Control – 9%
- Keep Kids/Children Safe – 8%
- Tornado Shelters – 6%
- Intruder Locks – 5%
- Keep Staff Safe – 5%
- More Police – 5%



Conclusions

Positive takeaways from the surveys:

- Most stakeholders feel safe at schools and school activities.
- Most stakeholders feels safety drills are important.
- Students and staff know what do in an emergency while in their classroom.

Areas for improvement:

- The Kansas Safety Hotline is not well known by all stakeholders.
- Stakeholders feel less confident about what to do in an emergency in other parts of the school other than their own classroom.
- Some parents have concerns about safety at dismissal time.
- Some secondary students do not feel as comfortable talking to someone at school about a safety issue.
