You are hereby notified that the Plaintiff's
 Attorney has chosen to initially proceed with this
 matter administratively and is making stipulation
 of exemptions available for the property seized for

You may do any of the following:

- File a verified petition for Request of
 Stipulation of Exemption with the Plaintiff's
 Attorney, sending a copy to the Seizing
 Agency;
- File a verified claim with the Plaintiff's
 Attorney and the Seizing Agency; or

The law also provides for provisional return of
 the property under certain circumstances including
 the posting of a surety bond or a Court hearing on
 whether probable cause existed when the property
 was seized.

You may wish to consult with an attorney
 before deciding what is best for you. However, if
 no petition or claim is filed within sixty (60) days
 of personal service, publication, or mailing of this
 Notice, whichever is earlier, your interest in the
 property described above will be forfeited. All such
 requests, petitions and claims shall comply with the
 requirements for claims as set out in ***K.S.A. 60-
 4111 of the Kansas Standard Asset Seizure and
 Forfeiture Act.***
