ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE WITH ACT **AMERICANS** DISABILITIES ADVISORY BOARD OF THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS: AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS

OF CHAPTER 2.16, ARTICLE VII OF THE DERBY MUNICIPAL CODE AND REPEALING THE ORIGINAL SECTIONS AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF

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Section 1. Section 2.16.300 of the Derby Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS:

"2.16.300 - Members - Term.

The board shall in the second guarter of each year, elect from its members a chair and vice-chair,

who shall serve in such capacity for one year. The City Manager's designee shall provide appropriate administrative support to the ADA Advisory Board. including but not limited to recording of meeting minutes." Section 2. Section 2.16.310 of the Derby Municipal

"2.16.310 - Meetings.

Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

The board shall meet annually or more frequently at the call of the chair or a majority of members as necessary to facilitate board business."

Section 3. Section 2.16.320 of the Derby Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"2.16.320 - Mission - Relationship to city council. A. The mission of the board shall be to work towards full compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act with respect to city facilities and activities, including but not limited to
