

ORDINANCE NO. 2473 SUMMARY

On October 12, 2021, the City of Derby, Kansas adopted Ordinance No. 2473 entitled:

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY D/B/A AT&T KANSAS, A CONTRACT FRANCHISE FOR THE PROVISION OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS AND PRESCRIBING THE TERMS OF SAID CONTRACT FRANCHISE.

Ordinance No. 2473 establishes an updated contract franchise with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Kansas to provide telecommunications services within the City, authorized uses of the City right-of-way, and provides for the payment of a franchise fee to the City of Derby. The franchise ordinance provides for a franchise fee equal to 5% of gross receipts. This is a change in fee structure from prior franchise ordinances with AT&T Kansas and is anticipated to provide additional franchise revenue to the City of Derby. The initial term of the franchise agreement is for the period January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024, with up to eight (8) additional two-year renewal terms authorized by the ordinance. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2022, following publication of this summary in *The Derby Informer* unless a sufficient petition for an election is filed in accordance with the timeframe and terms of K.S.A. 12-2001(m) in which instance this franchise ordinance will only take effect in accordance with the requirements of state law.
