## **RESOLUTION NO. 20-2025** A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING RESOLUTION NO. 052024 OF THE CITY OF DERBY,

KANSAS, WHICH DETERMINED THE ADVISABILITY OF MAKING CERTAIN IMPROVEMENT IN THE CITY (SANITARY SEWER-PHASE 1 IMPROVEMENTS/COURTYARDS AT CROSSWATER SECOND).

WHEREAS, the City has received and filed a revised Petition proposing modifications of the estimated costs of the improvements and the improvement district, and the City hereby finds and determines that said revised Petition is sufficient and that it is necessary to make such modifications; and
