

ORDINANCE NO. 2636

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO STIPENDS FOR MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY; AMENDING SECTION 2.04.010 OF THE DERBY MUNICIPAL CODE AND REPEALING THE ORIGINAL SECTION 2.04.010 AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS:

Section 1 . Section 2.04.010 of the Derby Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“ 2.04.010 – Stipends for members of governing body.

A. Amount of stipend.

1. The mayor shall, upon his or her election to accept the same, be entitled to receive a stipend of 1,000 dollars for each calendar month that he or she holds office, such stipend to be paid monthly.

2. Each council member shall, upon his or her election to accept the same, be entitled to receive a stipend of 500 dollars for each calendar month that he or she holds office, such stipend to be paid monthly.

B. In the event the tenure of a member of the governing body begins on a day other than the first day of a month or ends on a day other than the last day of a month, the stipend for such month shall be prorated for the number of days served.

C. No stipend shall be payable hereunder to any member of the governing body who does not elect to accept the same; provided, that such member may recommend that a donation equal to the amount of such stipend be made to an organization identified on the city’s approved list as contained in the then-current Governing Body Manual of the City of Derby.

Section 2 . Repeal

Original section 2.04.010 of the Derby Municipal Code is hereby repealed. All other provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Derby, Kansas shall remain in full force and effect except as specifically amended herein. All other ordinances or parts of other ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. However, any section of an existing ordinance not in conflict herewith is not repealed and remains in full force and effect.

Section 3. Severability

Should any section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance be found to be unconstitutional or is otherwise held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any remaining provisions herein.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2026, and the ordinance or a summary thereof shall be published once in the City’s official newspaper as provided by state law.
