A Motion for Review and Termination has been filed in this court requesting that the court find the parents of Dayton M. Davis and Rayne F. Davis unfit to have custody of such child(ren) and make an order permanently terminating the parental rights of such child(ren) who has previously been adjudged each a child in need of care.

You are required to appear before this court at **08:30 AM on Wednesday, August 17 and Tuesday, September 27, 2022**, in the District Court, Juvenile Department, 1900 East Morris, city of Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas; or prior to that time file your written response to the pleading with the clerk of this court. Failure to either appear or respond may result in the court entering judgment granting the requested action.

Each parent or other legal custodian of the children has the right to appear and be heard personally either with or without an attorney. The court will appoint an attorney to represent a parent who fails to appear.
