This project shall be constructed in accordance with the latest edition of the Mississippi Standard Specifications for State Aid Road and Bridge Construction.

The cost is fifty dollars (\$50) for the plans and fifty dollars (\$50) for the proposal, non-refundable. Plans and Proposals may also be downloaded by Bidders for electronic bidding purposes ONLY.
