MAIL ABSENTEE VOTING

Request an Absentee ballot application online: vote.elections.virginia.gov

Absentee ballots ARE counted.

FRIDAY, April 10, 2026: Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail.

Applications must be received in the respective County/City Voter Registrar's Office by **5:00 p.m.**

TUESDAY, April 21, 2026: Election Day – ALL POLLING LOCATIONS OPEN

ALL DROPPED OFF Absentee voted ballots must be returned to the respective Voter Registrar's Office by **7:00 p.m.** (Virginia Eastern Time) to be counted.

If mailing your ballot close to Election Day: In accordance with updated U.S. Postal Service guidance, voters are strongly advised to present their return ballot envelope at the post office counter and request an official postmark, as mailbox drop-offs may not receive a same-day postmark.
