




Midtown Connector & Intermodal Gateway Project

Corridor Improvements

MIDTOWN CONNECTOR ROADWAY REALIGNMENT

A new two-lane roadway links Mt. Crawford Avenue and North River Road, replacing unsafe offset intersections with a single signalized crossing and removing left-turn conflicts along Main Street.

WELLNESS CONNECTOR

Connects Midtown to the Bridgewater Community Center, Harrison Park, and the Wellness Quarter, providing a safe, direct route to key civic destinations.

NORTH LIBERTY SIDEWALK

A parallel north-south route converts part of North Liberty Street into a sidewalk, improving neighborhood connectivity and safety.

OAKDALE PARK SHARED USE PATH

A parallel north-south walking and biking (and golf cart) route added to improve neighborhood connectivity and safety.

COMMUNITY CROSSROADS TRANSPORTATION HUB & PUBLIC PLAZA

A new regional transit stop with shelters, wayfinding, and public space integrates transit, walking, and biking while creating a welcoming Midtown identity.
