# Revised Redistricting Proposal

Implementation for the 2024-2025 School Year

#### Rockingham County School Board Policy JC

#### SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

School attendance areas for each school are established by the School Board. Students shall attend the school in the attendance area in which they reside and to which they are assigned, unless special permission is granted by the Division Superintendent.

Changes in attendance areas shall be determined by the School Board, upon recommendation of the Superintendent based on the need to provide for the orderly administration of the schools, the instruction of the students, and the health, safety, best interests and general welfare of all students.

#### Why do we need to redistrict our students?

- Some may consider this a "necessary evil." Unfortunately, we can't move schools.
- To maximize, to the greatest extent possible, all the available space we have in our schools so we are not placing a burden on our taxpayers to build additional schools.
- To relieve current overcrowding in some of our schools. Most notably:
  - Cub Run
  - Montevideo
  - Spotswood
- To utilize the available space in our current schools where there is capacity to accommodate growth.
- To increase enrollment in our smaller schools to consistently allow for more than one teacher at each grade level. Also, to help with balancing class sizes in these schools.

#### Things we considered . . .

- As much as possible, tried NOT to move students from their high school attendance area. This is included in the proposal for some students, but not all.
- Relied heavily on our transportation department for guidance because we want to make sure the proposed new bus routes are efficient and effective.
- Made sure that we are not significantly changing the amount of travel time for students. In many cases, the travel time decreased.
- We reviewed current and upcoming developments within our county, including towns.

  - School Board decided to postpone vote until after an opportunity to visit schools impacted by redistricting
- January 18, 2024
  - Work Session to discuss school visits, transportation implications, and grandfathering clauses
- January 22, 2024
  - Final vote at next regular meeting (Elkton Middle School)
