

# Proposed Process for Potential Ineligible Registered Non-Citizen

**Voter Registration Records** (Department of State's (DOS) Florida Voter Registration System (FVRS))

Daily Process- New registered voter records

Existing registered voter records

**Automated match records -- potential registered non-U.S. citizens**

**Driver Licensee Records** (Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicle (DHSMV) Driver and Vehicle Information Database(DAVID))

## Manual and Initial Review Process (*Division of Elections*) (case-by-case)

- Verify identity
- Verify legal status
- Verify through SAVE** (U.S. Department of Homeland Security-DHS' Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements –SAVE database program) (individualized fee-based searches using alien registration number)
- Cross-checks with available secondary sources
- Prepare electronic case file
- Provide electronic case file to Supervisor of Elections

## Notice and Right to Be Heard Process under s. 98.075(7), F.S. (*Supervisors of Elections-SOEs*)

- Recommended **SAVE verification**
- **Notice to voter** (actual or if undeliverable, published in newspaper)
- **Opportunity to be heard** (30 days for voter to respond to actual or published notice)
- **Hearing** if requested by voter denying ineligibility
- Recommended **SAVE verification** before making final determination of ineligibility
- **Final determination** of eligibility or ineligibility
- **Removal** of ineligible registered non-U.S. citizen (recorded reason for removal in FVRS)
- **Notice to ineligible person regarding removal from the rolls**

## Due Process Rights

- Right to be heard (s. 98.075(7), F.S.)
- Right to receive notice after removal for being ineligible (s. 98.075(7)(a)5., F.S.)
- Right to appeal in circuit court (s. 98.0755, F.S.)
- Right to be restored to rolls (s. 98.081, F.S.)
