The actual assignment of the {construction permit}, including delivery of said {construction permit}  
{station license}, to the assignee, shall be completed within 30 days from the date hereof; and notice in letter form there-  
of shall forthwith be furnished the Commission by the assignee, showing when the acts necessary to give  
effect to the assignment have been completed. Upon furnishing the Commission with such written notice,  
assignee is authorized to begin the {construction permit} of the station in accordance with all the terms and  
conditions of said {construction permit}. This consent shall not authorize the {construction permit} of said  
{station license} station by assignee unless and until such notification has been forwarded to the Commission.

It is hereby directed that this consent, when effective, be attached to the above-described  
{construction permit}, posted as required by the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
