JP, I'm sorry to be so tardy in responding to your last letter, but frankly I'm in a quandary how to respond. This attached draft explains some of those concerns. As a City Council we've decided to stay with our original footprint and purchase no new properties and we are completing the purchase of properties that have been under contract but delayed by litigation. Sporting events must be a part of this arena as noted in this reply to me.

I know you've told us that you have personally walked the area to make your own observations. I would only ask that if you want to continue any dialogue that you would agree to walk the area with city historical experts to hear our perspective.
